

## **PL New Teachers Thriving Facilitator Job Description**

The BTU is excited to launch year two of our partnership with [New Teachers Thriving](#), a program which helps new educators understand and avoid the most common pitfalls that undermine the first year experience and which contribute to high levels of burnout, personal unhappiness, and job dissatisfaction.

**Position:** We seek BTU members interested in co-facilitating program sessions for the 2019-20 school year and possibly beyond. Lead Facilitator and co-facilitator positions available depending on interest, availability and qualifications.

### **Commitment/Workload:**

- attend all monthly program sessions (2 hrs on a weeknight see flyer linked above for tentative dates).
- commit ~5 hours/month between sessions for planning, reflection, preparation this includes:
  - ~1 hour monthly program meeting
  - ~2 hours preparation, planning, internalizing content including reading and familiarizing with research
  - ~1-2 hours feedback, responsiveness work with program participants
  - Lead Facilitator may require some additional hours.
- Consider possible future leadership opportunities within the program
- Specific schedule to be arranged

- Five years teaching experience (preferred) or if <5 years participated in NTT last year
- Experience facilitating professional learning
- Experience working in support of New educators
