Alumni programming offers you the opportunity to share your on-program experiences and skills learned while on your exchange with your community and wider network via community engagement, professional development, English language, and American culture events. 1. Alumni Database

2. Alumni Grants Program

Alumni may apply for individual/travel grants (**up to \$250**) or group grants (**up to \$3000**) to do projects that contribute to the social, economic, and civic development of their countries. Summaries of past projects that received funding through the program can be found at www.bradleyherald.org under Alumni/Projects & Activities/FLEX Grants. The online application is available in November and the deadline for submission is in February.

3. Global Youth Service Day (GYSD)

Alumni may apply for matching grants up to \$500 for GYSD projects. GYSD is an annual global event that highlights and celebrates the contributions of youth to their communities through service (www.gysd.org). The online application is available in November and the deadline for submission is in February.

4. FLEX Alumni Photo/Video Contest

Alumni are invited to submit pictures and videos taken at alumni events to the FLEX Alumni Photo and Video contest. Winning submissions will receive prizes. The contest will run from July – August 2015. Program start and end dates and promotional materials will be posted on social media sites.

5. International Education Week (IEW)

IEW is an opportunity to celebrate the benefits of international education and exchange worldwide. This annual initiative is part of an effort to promote international understanding and build support for international educational exchange. For more information, go to www.iew.state.gov.
