1. **Entries** will be completed online at www.athletic.net. Locate your state and school, click on “**Sign up Here**” and follow instructions. Once you receive your confirmation email, proceed to “**Edit Calendar**”. Where it says “**Add to the calendar**”. Select the date 2025 , May 1, and continue to **Marshland Invite Meet**. Entries must be submitted by **NOON Mon, April 28. Please e-mail me at rberry@mayville.k12.wi.us when you have received this information, so I can communicate if there is an issue with entries.**
2. You may make scratches the day of the Meet. If you want to **substitute**, you may do this by emailing me Wednesday, April 30th by noon. **No changes day of the meet only scratches.**
3. Please advise your athletes that they will be **allowed only** in the bathrooms in the bus garage. **Not in the high school.**
4. All awards will be placed in an envelope and given to the coaches at the end of the Meet in the press box.

6. School entry fee of \$175.00 includes both Boys & Girls Teams.
7. Please, both you and your athletes, cooperate with the officials. Also have your athletes ready to run when called. Remember that running events take precedence over field events. We will start at 4:15 p.m.
8. Once running events start, advise your athletes to stay off the track.
9. SCORING will be 10 - 8 - 6 - 5 - 4 - 3 - 2 - 1 and RELAYS 10- 8- 6- 5- 4- 3-2-1
10. Starting blocks will be furnished. Please inform your jumpers to tell the field judge when they are leaving the area to compete in another event. Athletes must return within 10 minutes of name calling or miss a turn.

11. Only 1/4" pin spikes or 3/8" spikes in a recessed waffle shoe will be allowed. We have a brand new surface on our track!

12. All officials have been instructed to keep the Meet running on time, so tell your athletes to listen to calls and be where they belong. WE WILL SCRATCH THEM FROM EVENTS IF THEY ARE NOT READY ACCORDING TO FEDERATION RULES.

In the past, this has always been a super meet. We strive to keep this meet enjoyable for all involved.
