# **Graduate School Funding Options**

Always remind people that you're a self-funding student. A good offer = a full waiver + five years of guaranteed funding + health insurance. If you're fully funded, which school is more expensive, Harvard (a private school), or NMU (a public school)? They're the same! In-state and out of state tuition will cost the same to you. Now, cost of living in Cambridge may be higher, but their stipend is also higher as well. Private schools often have larger endowments, they can be more generous.

Get all offers in writing. Winter of your senior year, have all calls go straight to voicemail. In February
schools will be reaching out and you want time to strategize! When you call back, act super pumped, then
ask what their funding is. "OMG Dr. X, I'm so glad you've called! Especially since you're from! I
love your What sort of package are you talking about? I'm required by my McNair Director to
get all offers in writing. Email is great, yes, <u>@nmu.edu</u> would be perfect. Yay, I'm so excited to hear
this great news!!"

Play offers against each other:

- "I love \_\_\_school/dept name\_, but I have unfortunately received offers that are more generous. What can we do?"
- "I've been offered admission elsewhere, but I would not like to be forced to make a decision without knowing where I stand with you."
- "I've come to learn of decisions from other schools, and I have yet to hear from you. I want to emphasize my commitment to department at school."

Always ask "Does the department fund all students? How do I become one of those you fund?"

Financial aid in grad school means loans, so never ask about it. You're looking for fellowships and assistantships. There are usually 3 types of assistantships at schools.

Teaching Assistant - assists with teaching, chosen by committee

Research Assistant - Helps with research, often grant-funded, chosen by the PI

Graduate Assistant - Job in the office, chosen the same way most jobs are - If your school has a McNair or any other TRiO programs, reach out. They may be hiring a GA.

You don't have to be perfect, but you do have to apply.
