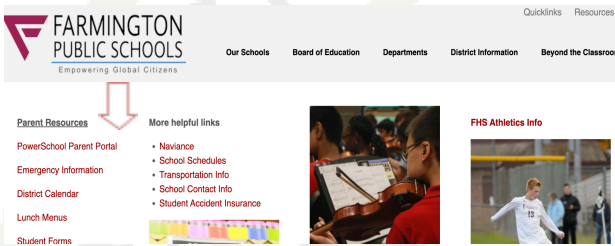


PowerSchool at IAR

Question	Answer
What is PowerSchool?	- PowerSchool is a website and app that allows students, parents, and guardians access to grades, assignments, scores, schedules, etc., for each school the student attends, used to keep everyone informed on a student's progress.
How do I access PowerSchool? 	- Students access PowerSchool through our fpsct.org website under the students tab. They do not have a username or password as they simply click "sign in here." - Parents and guardians access PowerSchool Parent Portal through our fpsct.org website under the Parent Resources tab. Parents and guardians use a separate username and password that is sent through a letter upon student registration. Once set up, parents are able to access PowerSchool with that username and password through the website or app.
What if I, as a parent or guardian, forgot my password?	- Parents and guardians should go to the Parent Portal, located on our fpsct.org website, under the parents tab. Click on "Forgot Username or Password" and fill out the form. A username or password reset will be sent to your original email that was used when signing up for PowerSchool.
What if the password reset button is not sending a code through?	- Check your original email that you used when you registered at FPS. Additionally, check any SPAM folders. If not, reach out to Bianca Ortiz: ortizb@fpsct.org, who can assist you.
How do I navigate the website or add another student?	- Navigate to our fpsct.org website, under the Parent Resources tab. There are helpful screencasts to show you how to create an account, navigate PowerSchool, and add an additional student.
