AP Letter to Families

Reminders for Parents/Guardians of AP Students

If your child is enrolled in an Advanced Placement (AP) course this year, they have more support than ever to help them learn throughout the year and prepare for AP Exams, where students have the opportunity to earn college credit!

Our team of AP teachers remain dedicated to providing your child with a powerful learning experience this year, and because we know the importance of parent involvement, we have a few updates to help your child stay on track:

- Make sure your child uses the join code their AP teacher gives them to join their class section. This will give them access to AP Classroom where they can practice their skills, receive feedback on their progress, and see real AP Exam questions. Students must complete this step by September 26 if their AP class begins Trimester 1. Students that start an AP class trimester 2 will complete this process at a later date. This is the first step in their AP exam registration. More information will be provided throughout the year.

 - The payment window is October 1 October 31 for all courses that begin in Trimester 1. Students that are in an AP course that does not begin until Trimester 2 will pay at a later date for those exams. The fee is \$60 for each exam. If students qualify for F/R lunch, the fee is \$10.
 - Directions on how to pay will be communicated to families and teachers before that time.
- Remind your child to watch AP learning videos. Starting on September 1, short, on-demand learning videos called "AP Daily" will be available in AP Classroom. AP students can watch these at their own pace on a mobile device or a computer with internet access, or teachers can assign them as part of their curriculum. These are available for most courses.
- Encourage your child to register for their AP Exams in the fall so that they have the chance to stand out to college admissions officers and save money on tuition with a qualifying score of three or more.

AP Exams are non-refundable. Please make sure your students are aware of that.
