You have been invited to attend the 2025 State Walter Trumbauer Theatre Competition held this year in Birmingham, AL at The University of Alabama at Birmingham on December 5th & 6th. This competition is the next step after winning your Superior Rating at District Trumbauer. You will get to compete at the state level against other high school students from around the state. You will compete in your categories within your divisions, novice, intermediate, or varsity, for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place in the state of Alabama!

Seniors will have the opportunity to be involved in the Alabama Conference of Theatre College and University Screening Auditions. Interested seniors will need to submit their applications by Nov. 7th. Students will audition on campus during the festival for college and university representatives for scholarships and recruitment. A college fair will be set up during the festival that invites all students to visit and learn more about theatre after high school! Scholarships will be announced Saturday evening during the awards ceremony.

### **Brief Itinerary:**

Students will depart from Mountain Brook High School on December 5th NO LATER THAN 1:30 p.m. Students will travel by a charter bus to Florence, Al. to the Marriott in Muscle Shoals hotel in Muscle Shoals, Alabama where they will be staying through the weekend. Students will be bussed to and from The University of North Alabama at the beginning and end of Friday and Saturday. Students will return to Mountain Brook High School on Saturday night between 11:00 p.m. and 11:30 p.m. *(this arrival time is subject to change)*
