1. The meeting was called to order by D. Ayers at 3:06 p.m.

2. Approval of minutes of February 11, 2026. *Hearing no objections, the minutes are approved.*

3. Reports. a. Chairs Report. D. Ayers reported: S. Eubanks went to Rules because he was unable to attend. AP 303-23 Classroom Attendance was sent back to UAC for a minor change. AP 303-24 Grading, Grade Changes, and Grade Appeals; they talked about GAC's edits without looking at all the UAC revisions and that will be discussed at the next meeting. AP 303-30 Registration; they brought something up about the paragraph that follows the changes GAC made but hasn't been revised. J. Ayers stated the idea is your FAP should do what the Declaration of Candidacy should be. **This will be unfinished business at the next meeting.**

5. New Business. a. 303-22 Graduate Students; 2-5 a. English Language Proficiency. D. Ayers stated this is a minor change. S. Eubanks stated they would like to add the Duolingo as a test in the policy. It is cheaper and faster. They want to bump the IELTS score from 6.0 to 6.5 since we are at a lower rate than any other institution. Any ideas or comments please let D. Ayers know. **This will come back as unfinished business at the next meeting.**

b. New CPAC Rubrics. D. Ayers stated over the next few months his goal is to work on policy and the new CPAC rubrics. If you have any feedback on how things went, what was frustrating, what could make it easier, etc. please let him know.
