## Summary

### General Information

"Arts and Academics," is one of the final units available in the Rosetta Stone curriculum. With four lessons containing multiple listening, pronunciation, vocabulary, reading, speaking, and writing activities for English Language Learners, the unit offers a balanced approach to language instruction as it teaches vocabulary relevant to the topic of arts and academics. Through image-matching activities, listening and repeating activities, and reading/listening comprehension activities, students stretch their skills to the intermediate level (the highest level available in Rosetta Stone) through implicit learning. The grammar forms this unit most heavily focuses on include a broad array of clauses and phrases, helping students begin to acquire an understanding of and ability to produce complex and compound sentences, while students also gain the ability to bring a deeper level of cohesiveness to their speaking and writing through the unit's focus on transitional words and phrases. Students are also exposed to texts where the speakers express their opinions, providing students with valuable input for conversations in daily life and academic settings. As in all other units, the English Language Proficiency Standards most commonly addressed are 1, 2, 3, 7, 8, 9, and 10. This particular unit functions almost entirely in descriptor level 3 (NRS 4).
