## Illinois' Small Utility Clean Energy Planning Support Program Fact Sheet

## **Summary:**

The State of Illinois plans to develop a "Small Utility Clean Energy Planning Support" program to provide technical and financial assistance to municipal and co-op utilities in Illinois to help them identify a path to transition the state's power sector to carbon-free by 2045. The funding for the support will come from the state's successful Climate Pollution Reduction Grant award. The IEPA maintains a <a href="website">website</a> with information about the state's \$430 million dollar award. About \$2.6 million will be spent on the Small Utility Clean Energy Planning Support program over a five year period.

The information summarized below about the new "Small Utility Clean Energy Planning Support" technical assistance and grants is found in Illinois' "Climate Pollution Reduction Grant Implementation Grant."

Task: Small Utility Clean Energy Planning Support

**Description:** Small Utility Clean Energy Planning Support: ICB will develop a technical assistance resource, and make strategic planning grants, to help eligible municipal and co-op utilities assess needs and identify ways to replace fossil fuels with renewable energy.

Agency: Illinois Finance Authority (IFA) / Illinois Climate Bank (ICB)

**Key Activity/Deliverable:** Launch new grants program to municipal and coop utilities. Competitive procurement of expert.

Key Milestones: Launch grants: 2026, Q1

Total 5 yr Budget: \$2,616,250

## Planned Activities:

- 1. Contract for Technical Expertise: \$350,000 over 5 years to develop a technical reference and provide ongoing support to utilities.
- 2. Grants to Municipal and Co-op Utilities: Two annual grants of \$200,000 each to help municipal and co-op utilities secure power system and generation plans and renewable energy purchase agreements.
