Follow Up Discussion:

School counselor taught the lessons on kindness and empathy that we reviewed as a council at the last meeting and it went well.

Safe Walking Route Plan

- SCC chair sign plan
- Feedback on different areas:
 - Church parking lot - Staff helper is a needed addition for safety in this area. School is working toward finding a replacement.
 - Sidewalk - city has made previously requested upgrades for safety.
 - School grounds - people are dropping off in undesignated areas. Maybe a reminder to drop off in the yellow zone could help.
 - Fence by kindergarten playground needs to be extended to prevent people walking in dangerous areas. This is in process of being addressed with district facilities management.
 - West side, parents are parking and kids are crossing the parking lot to get to their parents.
 - What is the process for kids who ride bikes to school and how to get your bike if your child checks out midday? School will clarify these procedures with parents.

Proposed 2024-25 Land Trust Plan

- We have a Math goal, Reading Goal, and Resource Goal. Art will be integrated into core subjects
- Wit and Wisdom curriculum is being implemented with positive feedback.

- Creating curriculum maps with cross curricular opportunities to address science and social studies.

Review TSSA Plan

- Aligns with the Land Trust plan
- Coaching component, Achievement component, school generated component are required.
- Coaching component will target most vulnerable students
- Assistants will be hired to support RTI
- Add Tier 1 supports to TSSA plan

Standing Rules

 - 4 parent positions
 - 2 school staff positions
