Lesson Objectives	Students will be able to identify the seven principles of art.
Lesson Outline	<p>Students will first learn about the principles of art through class discussion. Students will be able to use their books and online resources (Google search, Wikipedia) to research one of the principles with their table as a group. The groups will report to the whole class about their principles by showing their work on the smart document camera. I will then type our class definitions on a Google Doc, for students to see on the smart board while they find examples of three. Students will have access to the google doc as a reference for completing their project (mentioned below). Students will then be expected to do some research on their own (using Google image search to find artwork examples) to identify three of the seven elements. They will submit the three example on Edmodo, in order for me to check their work.</p> <p>During the week students will be working on a project to represent all seven elements of art. Students draw seven hands on their paper and inside each hand they create a design to represent one of the elements. Students must identify the principles and how they represented them on the back of their paper.</p>

LESSON TOPIC: Principles of Art, 7th Grade

How Technology Will Be Used in lesson	<p>Smart board: will be used to put up the groups google drawings while they explain the term.</p> <p>Edmodo: will be used by the students to submit their examples and definitions.</p> <p>Chromebooks/laptops: will be used (depending on what is available) by students to research the principles and create a google drawing.</p> <p>Google Drawing: Students will be put into groups of 4 and create a google drawing, over one of the seven principles of art, to share with the class.</p> <p>Google Document: Each student will create a google document identifying the seven principles of art, as we discuss as a class. This will be turned in on Edmodo.</p>
Assessment	<p>Principles of art quiz on Edmodo.</p> <p>Class participation with their group to define a principle of art.</p> <p>Google Document with definitions of the seven principles of art.</p> <p>Project showing their own designs of each of the seven principles.</p>
