





- Steven De Costa took the floor, briefly discussing his submission for the Global Data Barometer and Data Vision Challenge, highlighting its evolution from the Open Data Barometer and his approach to exploring the dataset authentically, emphasizing the intent behind the data rather than just the data itself.
- Steven De Costa discussed exploring ways to revitalize the open data movement since the beginning of the year, viewing his work as a "co-construction" influenced by various AI models and past experiences. He detailed the iterative process of developing a data set, starting with three versions in three days and then refactoring to enhance security and migrate to MySQL, emphasizing the importance of exposing his process and the social connections fostered by data. Steven De Costa also shared his idea of using a simple question, such as whether it's raining in various countries, to demonstrate how data can come from different perspectives, highlighting that past weather data quality can provide better inferences about the present.
- Steven De Costa highlighted that data is historically anchored and that understanding this is crucial, as forgetting it means missing the point. He explained that everything is measurable by time, space, and probability, which largely determines coherence and possibility. De Costa stated that the Global Data Barometer focuses on individuals' perspectives and possibilities rather than top-down views of countries, noting that his own privilege influenced his approach. He also discussed his intention to encourage playful interaction with data, using a "physics explorer" game to understand data through physical play

- and revealing that some of the data presented was manufactured by AI, emphasizing the importance of fact-checking.
- Steven De Costa explained his aim to include co-creation of actual datasets from individuals with lived experiences, considering the probabilities relevant to them. He then described the project's features, including unlocking a 44th country, Australia, by tomorrow, and a timeline of content and walkthroughs. Steven De Costa also discussed CKAN as a co-constructor tool, emphasizing its role in empowering communities and noting that it is not merely software but a platform with both technical and social tracks, the latter of which he is eager to develop further.
- Steven De Costa discussed the importance of a data commons for public outcomes and planning, highlighting the growing recognition of individuals' unique data histories. He emphasized that the social track, much like the technical track, can develop "uncommon capabilities" to address these diverse needs. Steven De Costa also noted that the community surrounding CKAN and similar projects forms a trusted foundation for tackling complex challenges, allowing CKAN to engage with audiences that newer projects might not access. He concluded by differentiating between a protective and a proactive humanist approach to AI, referencing Creative Commons' work on signaling AI usage expectations and proposing the creation of positive datasets for co-creation with AI, in contrast to the potential for "digital authoritarianism" arising from data control.





1. Ask CKAN questions—get instant answers

What if CKAN had an AI assistant to help you find datasets, understand metadata, and navigate the platform—just by chatting? ckanext-chat brings an AI-powered chat interface to CKAN. It understands CKAN commands, retrieves insights, and makes data more accessible—even for non-technical users.

2. Instantly generate metadata—no manual work required

Metadata is crucial for making datasets searchable and useful—but filling it in manually? Nobody enjoys that. <u>Data Resource Upload First (DRUF)-enabled DP+</u> automates metadata creation while you upload data. No extra effort, no missing details—just clean, structured metadata every time.

3. Create interactive charts, maps, and tables—directly in CKAN

Data on CKAN doesn't have to sit in spreadsheets forever. What if you could turn it into interactive visualizations—right inside CKAN? With ckanext-querytool you can transform CKAN datasets into interactive visualizations using Plotly (for charts), DataTables (for tables), and Leaflet (for maps)—all without leaving CKAN or needing extra software.

4. Change CKAN settings without IT help

Every CKAN admin knows the pain of tweaking settings—logging into servers, modifying config files, restarting the system. It shouldn't be this hard. With ckanext-editable-config CKAN admins can modify settings via Web UI—no need for DevOps, no downtime.

5. Never miss a critical error again

When something goes wrong in CKAN, errors get logged—but who actually checks those logs? They often go unnoticed. ckanext-push-errors automatically sends

critical errors to Slack or any other system so teams can catch and fix issues in real time.

6. Manage files more flexibly in CKAN

CKAN's default file handling can be limiting. What if you need more flexibility? ckanext-files makes it easier to upload, manage, and attach files directly to datasets and resources, offering more flexibility in organizing data.

With support from Academia Sinica and grants from Taiwan's National Science and Technology Council, depositar has grown to host over 2,500 datasets and received 500,000+ unique views. Its users span universities, research institutions, and civic groups, particularly those involved in ecological monitoring. Key features of <u>depositar</u> include:

- Accepting diverse data types and formats across academic disciplines.
- Enabling research communities in Taiwan to embrace open data practices.
- Leveraging CKAN's flexibility to integrate tools like ARK persistent identifiers and Binder.

I would like to ask if Ckan can read data from heterogeneous data sources, and can be used for ETL jobs. Also, if data quality and data governance is covered in its features.  - 1) CKAN accepts any kind of data file by default, but will not connect directly to data sources like relational databases or data services

- 2) Data quality is covered mainly trough extensions like ckanext-scheming and ckanext-validation, there are some backed in features for data governance like user roles or data collaborators but you probably will want to extend it
- 3) For most customizations you will need to write some code

 - CKAN's default resource viewer for tabular data is Recline, which was developed in 2012. Currently, it is being upgraded to Portal.js, but is still WIP. In this talk, we review the revamped DataTables view, which leverages the popular DataTables library, that is a modern drop-in

replacement for the Recline resource viewer with extended features beyond "data exploration."

- Joel Natividad is a passionate open data evangelist, entrepreneur, futurist, semtechie and a long time open source contributor.
