Dear Parents/Guardians of Middle and High School Students,

It was great to see students entering the building this week even though things looked a little different. For our hybrid students we wanted to send out a few reminders and updates.

- <u>VERY IMPORTANT</u> Students will NOT be allowed to enter the building until 7:40 am. Parents/guardians if you are dropping off your child or if your child is a walker, *make sure* they arrive very near 7:40 am. Your son/daughter will remain outside, socially distanced, until the doors are open at 7:40 am. Additionally, it is expected that each car will enter the loop and pull ahead to the furthest available position and exit the passengers noting that you may not be dropping off your child at the position closest to the door all sidewalks conveniently lead to the entry door of our school. Please be aware of the many cars behind you that need to access this loop.
- Students must wear masks when they are in school at all times. Mask breaks will be provided during their classes.
- This year all students K-12 can receive a free breakfast or lunch. If a student is getting breakfast they will need to pick it up as they go through the cafeteria and bring it to their 1st period class.
- Make sure your child is checking their school email daily and often. Teachers will be reaching out to students, communicating via email, and/or assigning work/review in google classroom on their virtual days. This will also be the teachers way to take attendance on the virtual days.
- Some student schedules were adjusted, please use the parent/student portal to confirm schedules.
- The <u>Curriculum Nights</u> that were planned for the middle school and high school are being <u>postponed</u>. With the new hybrid model beginning we are still meeting students and continue to establish new routines and procedures. The postponement of curriculum night will assist in bringing more valuable information for our Tonawanda City families to explore at an upcoming date.
- **Hybrid Students** Picture day will be September 14th, 15th, 17th and 18th during your child's Phys. Ed. classes. *Retakes* will be on October 29th. **Remote Warriors** there will be an opportunity to get your picture taken, more information to come.
