Agreement of previous minutes: (John)

Review of Previous Action Items:

1. Playground Updates (John)

- John spoke with Paul Walsh (Porter family representative) and was informed that the climbing structure is going to tender. The Educational Foundation will work with Sammy's Foundation to transfer funds once a vendor is selected. The Foundations work is complete and final steps lie with ELESD. Looking at late summer/early fall for installation.
- Structure recognition Admirals is reviewing "in memory of" recognition options for the structure.

 Admirals Academy has not yet heard back on their provincial wellness grant application – timeline for notice is any time between now and March 31, 2024

2. Fundraising (John)

- Council has agreed to run a spring 50/50 draw building on the success of last years campaign. Date TBC
- Exciting news Admirals was informed that 2023 Chromebook expiry dates have been extended for another 7-10 years. John has inquired if the Chromebooks recently removed from circulation will also receive an extension.
