As a part of our Social Studies Economics unit, the second grade students at Pinebrook will be having a Product Fair on May 25th.

Each student needs to create/produce an item for the Product Fair. Students need to make 5 of the same products. Some examples of products the students could make and bring in are:

- small handcrafted items such as paper bag puppets, coin banks, braided jewelry, games, toys, or artwork. Pinterest is a great resource to think of ideas!
- **Absolutely NO food items or GLASS ITEMS!!!**

Products should be made from everyday items, recycled objects, or cheap craft materials.

The students will use **fake money** to buy and sell products. Students will price their items to be either \$1, \$2, or \$3.
