

# Mobility at Pinewoods Camp

Pinewoods Camp is becoming more accessible with each passing year. The Dining Hall, Camp House, and all of the outdoor pavilions are wheelchair-accessible. Several housing choices on either pond are now accessible and a new, gently sloping path is being created from the main path to Hands Across (formerly C#).

Some campers who have mobility restrictions have rented scooters for their stay at Pinewoods. If you plan on renting a scooter, please keep the following in mind when talking to a scooter rental company: Wheels must be no less **than 3 inches wide with diameters of no less than 10 inches**. These dimensions are essential. Many scooters are designed to travel through malls and on nice, flat, hard sidewalks. Those scooters have smaller wheels and fail at Camp for two reasons: they either fall over or they get stuck.

You can rent either a 3-wheel model or a 4-wheel model. 3-wheel models generally have a smaller turning radius and are easier to maneuver, but they tip over more easily. The 4-wheel models offer a more solid footing. Note however, that both models can tip over if not driven with caution.

The scooters come apart in two pieces and can be transported in a large automobile. Wheelchair Express also delivers to Pinewoods for an additional fee.
