

### Task 3: Create a Pre-HBP theory to Voldemort's return

In my opinion, the new Voldemort is a reincarnation similar to the Inferi, only his is a stronger form of dark magic. He's still on the other side of the "Veil", but part of his soul has been rehabilitated in a new body, and he relies on dark magic to sustain that connection.
