Will it be an approved internship?

- Will the experience in nature be meaningful? If so, how?
- Does it align with the student's post high school goals/interests? If so, how?
- Will it allow for the student to have a supervisor/mentor who can train, set expectations, and provide feedback?
- Does the internship better prepare the student for a specific career/position after high school graduation? If so, what career or industry?
- Will the student be able to complete a minimum of 60 hours of applied/hands-on experience through this internship?

If you can't answer yes to all of the above questions, then it is likely not a good fit for an internship.
