
Updates on USAU are in progress, please note that pools state more games than actually exist. Please follow the spreadsheet.

But here we are! Thanks for sticking with us. We hope for dry fields on Sunday, but we will keep you all posted. **For now:**

The tournament will take place on two field sites, <u>Muir Fields (fields 1-3)</u> and La Jolla Country Day (fields 4-5) - shortened to LJCDS. Thankfully, the field sites are very close! Only an 8 min drive and 3.2 miles, a pleasant jog.

 - This will be the crossover games labeled as CR1: AP2 v DP3
 - Meaning that the team in the final 2 position of pool A will play the team in the final 3 position of pool D
 - i.e. W-L of Pool A plays L-W of Pool D

 - Top 2 teams from each pool will go to quarters!

 Will proceed with the same semis and finals schedule as before (fields should be good by Monday at the latest)

Trainers

Athletic Trainers will be on hand for taping and emergencies. If you do wish to be taped, please bring your own taping supplies, especially KT tape. Due to the limited number of athletic trainers, they will only be able to help players with injuries that happen at the tournament. They won't have time to do an eval for a pre-existing injury. You should also not rely on our trainers to give you a recommendation on whether you should be playing on said pre-existing injury. There is a \$30 charge for unreturned crutches.

In case of an emergency, alert the Athletic Trainers at Tournament Central immediately and they will call an ambulance if necessary.

Facilities and Sustenance

Showers are available in:

- 1. RIMAC arena locker rooms. Enter through the ground level doors on the south end of RIMAC field.
- 2. Canyon View Recreation Center across the street from Warren Field.

In order to shower at our facilities, you will need to present a student ID.

Bagels, bagel accessories, bananas and water refill stations will be provided at all fields. However, please refrain from eating on any turf fields.

Field Safety Notes:

Space is very limited and there have already been some serious accidents this year with folks getting in the way and/or blindsided while standing in tight spaces. So while we work to mitigate safety risks by changing field layout, we ask that you please help us out so we don't have to police this:

-<u>Warmup space will be limited</u>. Please share space where able and try to vacate fields asap after games have finished.

-Please do not drop equipment in tight spaces. This leaves no place for folks to stand/walk without going onto fields. Equipment needs to be not only behind "player lines" but also behind "equipment lines".

-Some fields have almost no space between them. Please work hard to limit non-playing folks in this space, with the safest being no folks.

-When standing on the sideline, please keep at least a few steps back to maximize effective play area and exciting plays—like toe-in dives, curved out/in throws, etc. It also allows our dedicated fans, parents, and media to be able to see and appreciate all our actions better!



-Unfortunately, bigger things like tables, tents, chairs, coolers, blow-ups, etc., should be kept only in the most open spaces which are limited and at the perimeter of the complexes.
