SPECIAL SESSIONS FOR THIS WEEK:

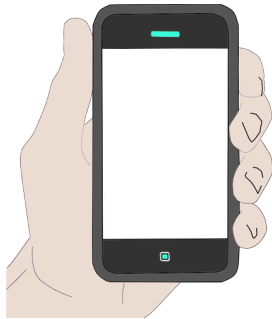

STUDENT DRIVERS
