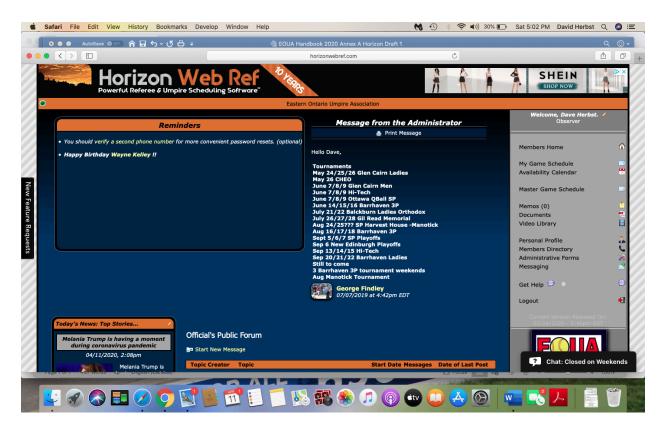
# **HorizonWebRef**

HorizonWebRef (Horizon) is the web based assigning tool that is used by the Eastern Ontario Umpire Association (EOUA). The web address is <a href="http://www.HorizonWebRef.com">http://www.HorizonWebRef.com</a>. Horizon is available on your computer or laptop through this address or you can install the Horizon App on your smart phone or tablet. (You can use all three.) The best way to discover Horizon is to use it and try the various features.

The first step is to contact the Treasurer/Assignor and obtain access to Horizon.

# **Home Page**

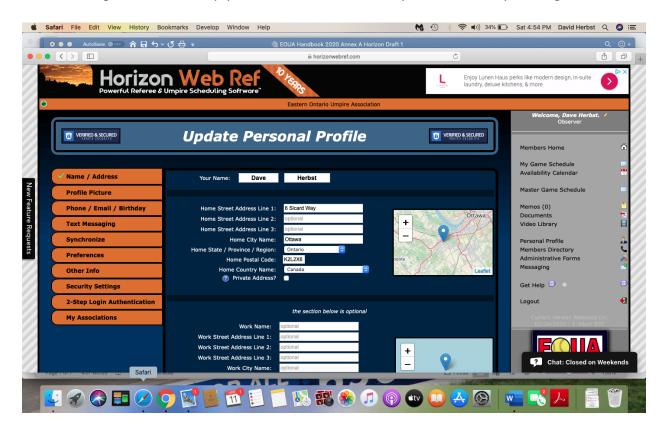
The Home Page is the first page that appears every time that you access Horizon.





### **Personal Profile**

The first thing to do is to set up your Personal Profile. Complete the tabs by clicking on them.



#### **Name Address Tab**

Your name and address are required. Your work information is optional. At this point you can also click on the two "I agree" buttons at the bottom of the page. If you do not agree, you cannot access Horizon.

#### **Profile Picture**

You can upload a picture of yourself. This is optional.

## Phone / Email / Birthday

Add your phone numbers and email addresses that you wish the Treasurer/Assignor to use for communication and to which you want your Pay sent. These phone numbers and email addresses will appear on the Directory, unless you indicate that you wish them to be private. If



you indicate private, other Members will not have access to this information. This could adversely impact pre-game communication with you.

## **Text Messaging**

If you complete this section you will receive information by text regarding upcoming games, changes and cancellations.

## **Synchronize**

This section allows you to synchronize Horizon with your Google Calendar or Facebook Connect. If you synchronize with Google Calendar all of your assignments will automatically be posted to your calendar.

#### **Preferences**

This section allows you to customize Horizon. If you do nothing, Horizon uses its defaults.

#### Other Information

The EOUA does not require completion of this section, although you may complete it if you wish.

# **Security Settings**

You must add at least one phone number to this section. Your mobile number is recommended.

### 2 Step Login Authentication

This is optional.

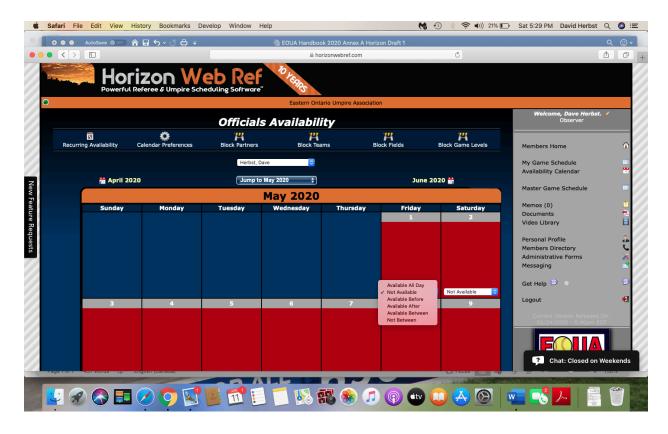
### My Associations

Horizon automatically completes this section for you. If you are a member of more than one association that uses Horizon, you will have all of these listed.



# **Availability Calendar**

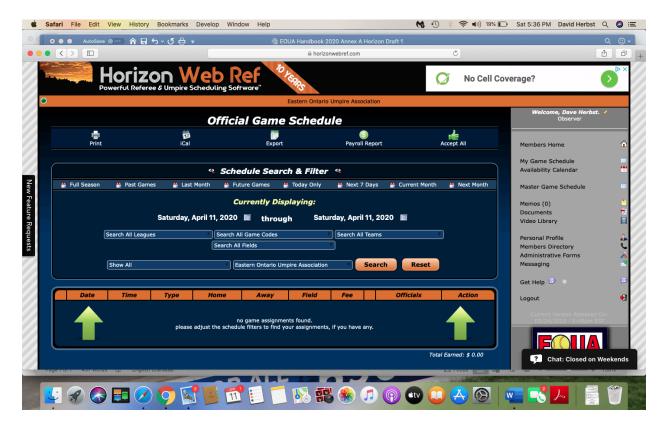
This is the place where you tell the Treasurer/Assignor when you are available to umpire games. You can indicate full, some or no availability on a day. You should set your availability as far in advance as possible. This enables flexibility for the Treasurer/Assignor and also enables you to be assigned games when you are available. You can edit your availability until a game is assigned to you on a date.





# My Game Schedule

This is where you receive your game assignments.



When you are assigned a game, you must indicate whether you accept or decline it. If you decline it, you need to provide a reason why you are declining it when you had indicated that you were available. Using the Schedule Search and Filter feature, you can view any part of your assigned schedule for the year.

This page provides you with the;

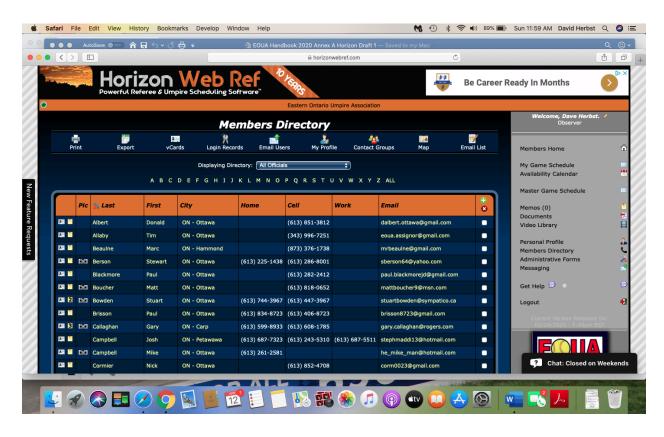
- Date,
- Time,
- Location,
- League,
- Teams,
- Game fee minus the assigning fee, and
- Partner(s).

If you need to return an assigned game, you must contact the assignor directly by phone. You must actually speak to them. Leaving a voice, text or email message is not sufficient. It is very important that the assignor knows that you want to return a game so that we do not miss coverage of a game.



# **Members Directory**

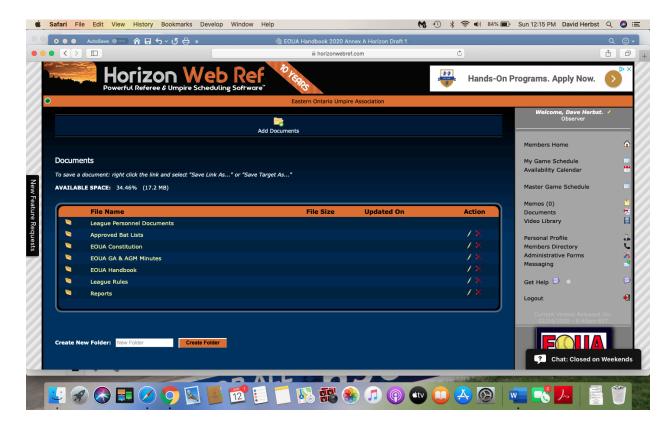
All Active Members are listed in the Directory. (There are also a number of umpires listed in the Directory who are not Members as the Assignor uses the tool to assign non-Member umpires to certain tournaments.) Unless a Member has indicated his contact information is private, it will appear in the Directory. You can scroll down the list or click a letter to go directly to a Member. If you are scrolling down, you need to click on "All" in the alphabetic list of letters in order to see all of the Members.
