

# Saying Hey Daisies

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## Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets:** Saying Hey (163697); Cheerful Daisies (161290)
- **Card Stock and Paper:** Basic White cardstock (159276); Crumb Cake cardstock (120953); Pretty In Pink cardstock (163793)
- **Stamp Pads & Ink:** Pretty In Pink ink pad (163807); Crumb Cake ink pad (147116); Craft Stampin' Ink (147277)
- **Tools:** Paper Trimmer (152392); Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653); Nested Essentials dies (161597)
- **Miscellaneous:** Stampin' Seal (152813); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); Pretty In Pink 3/8" Ribbon (163784)



## Measurements:

- Pretty In Pink: 8 1/2" x 5 1/2" (score at 4 1/4")
- Basic White: 3 7/8" x 5 1/8" (mat), scrap for die cutting
- Crumb Cake: 3 3/4" x 5" (card layer)
- Pretty In Pink ribbon: approx. 4"

## Instructions:

1. Using white Craft Stampin' Ink, stamp the small daisy and leaf from the Cheerful Daisies set all over to create a background. Set aside to dry.
2. Fold the Pretty In Pink cardstock in half to create the card base.
3. On the white scrap, stamp the following from the Saying Hey set as shown in the picture:
  - a. Hey – Pretty In Pink
  - b. I'm glad you exist – Crumb Cake
4. Die cut out the words using a rounded rectangle from the Nested Essentials dies.
5. Run a small strip of Stampin' Seal on the back and stick the ribbon to it so that some shows on either side of the rectangle. Trim ribbon ends.
6. Apply Stampin' Dimensionals on the back of the die cut piece and stick it to the Crumb Cake layer in the top 1/3.
7. Stick the Crumb Cake layer to the Basic White layer.
8. Stick the Basic White layer to the Pretty In Pink card base.
