	Flexibility and Elaboration	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Consider a range of strategies to represent ideas. ● Examine learning strategies including visualizing ideas, summarizing and paraphrasing information, and reflect on the application of the strategies in different contexts. ● Compare the difference between big picture thinking and planning through small elements.
	Originality	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Develop new ideas or concepts by linking seemingly unconnected information. ● Organize information or ideas and make original additions to it.
Research Skills	Sources	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Explain what a source is, categorize different types of sources, and know how to select the appropriate source for the purpose. ● Evaluate information from a variety of student selected sources to create a valid claim.
	Inquiry	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Evaluate the effectiveness of thought provoking questions when solving problems. ● Intentionally chooses questioning strategies to obtain information. ● Choose multiple effective strategies to investigate from a range of teacher-prescribed procedures.
Awareness Skills	Multiple Perspectives	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Accept others' rights to their perspective and may reevaluate his or her viewpoint in light of others' thinking.
	Self-Acceptance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Analyze how emotional responses may change in different contexts. ● Identify areas of improvement in one's self and explain why improving in that area might benefit them. ● Explore coping strategies for a challenging task.
