Keywords: three to five words that are closely related to the substance of the article. Keywords are typed with Ebrima font, 10 font size, Italic, and single spacing 1.0.

ABSTRACT (written in English, Capital letters, Ebrima 10, Bold, Indent Left) Should be clear and concise, written in English (single spacing 1.0), consisting of 150-200 words, typed with Ebrima font, 10 font size, justified margin alignment. The abstract contains research problem and questions to be answered, research findings, author's argument, and conclusions.

Keywords: between 3 to 5 words, Ebrima font, 10 font size, Italic, and single spacing 1.0.

INTRODUCTION (Capital letters, Ebrima 10 pt bold, left indented alignment)

Introduction contains general background, problem formulation (derived from the disagreement between empirical reality / "das sein" and ideal / "das sollen" conditions), research (gaps / voids resulted from the review of previous studies on the related topic), research novelty/contribution, the author's main argument, and the purpose of writing the article. The first line of the second paragraph and the following paragraphs is written indented.

METHOD (Capital letters, Ebrima 10 pt bold, left indented alignment)

Minimum research method consists of research type, type and source of data, data collection techniques, and data analysis techniques. The first line of the second paragraph and the following paragraphs is written indented.

RESULT (Capital letters, Ebrima 10 pt bold, left indented alignment)

This section describes the results of the research that has been carried out. Research results can be presented with the support of tables, graphs/pictures. In its presentation, it must begin with a narration first, then followed by a table or picture

DISCUSSION (Capital letters, Ebrima 10 pt bold, left indented alignment)

This section contains an analysis of the cases / topics which is based on the predefined analytical framework. Discussion is subdivided into categories based on elements / components / variables in the analytical framework. In this section, the author can also add a separate section to discuss additional things which are not included in the previous categories. In this section the author should clearly state the answer to the research question. The first line of the second paragraph and the following paragraphs is written indented.

CONCLUSION (Capital letters, Ebrima 10 pt bold, left indented alignment)

The conclusion part does not contain repetitions or fragments described in the previous section of discussion. This section reaffirms the case / issue topics focused in the writing, the main argument(s), and the findings in a concise way. In this section, the author presents critical reviews to the analytical framework used in the writing and provides advice on future studies of the related cases / topics.

BIBLIOGRAPHY (Capital letters, Ebrima 10 pt bold, left indented alignment)

Bibliography is written in Ebrima font, 9 pt., and 1.15 spacing. Each entry of the bibliography uses a 1.25-cm-sized hanging indent. The bibliographic list should have been written in ascendingly alphabetical order of the last name of the authors. References of manuscripts originating from more than one type should be classified according to books, journals, research reports, working papers, seminar papers, newspapers / magazines, official publications, annual reports, articles and other media at the time of initial submission. We recommend using citation devices on References tools in MS Word, Mendeley, Grammarly, or Endnote.
