Note:

The theory course for license exchange (TA) lasts 2x 50 minutes and is offered as one course module. The introduction to the Learner's Permit (TE) lasts 60 Minutes. A driving lesson lasts 50 minutes and is only booked as a double lesson (1x 100 minutes). The practical test preparation lasts 100 minutes. Payments are due at the time of booking. Driving lessons and courses must be canceled or rescheduled latest three (3) business days and tests five (5) business days in advance, otherwise the appointment will be charged in full.

Registration Online/driving school

To register for the exchange education for car, you can either fill out our [online](#) form from home or on the go - or simply stop by and complete the registration in the driving school if you prefer. To complete the registration, we need a copy of your Austrian Meldezettel and valid photo ID. We also need a copy of the driver's license from the person(s) you will be practicing driving with (must have had a driver's license for 7 years and regularly driven a car for the last three years). After that, the registration is complete :)

Doctor's report (Arztgutachten) Optional/driving school

In order to submit the application for the license exchange at the Verkehrsamt (transport department in Vienna), you need to complete a driving license health check-up to get a medical certificate. The doctor's report must be submitted to the Verkehrsamt as soon as possible after registration or with your application. The application will not be processed without a doctor's report. Note that the report must be issued by a doctor who is authorized to perform health check-ups for the driving license (your GP is not eligible!). By the way, you can also do the health check-up for the driver's license at the driving school. [Find and book an appointment](#) now!

Application License Exchange Verkehrsamt

The application for a license exchange is personal, meaning that you have to submit it to the Verkehrsamt yourself - we are unfortunately not able to do this for you. We can and are, however, happy to help you with the preparation of the application package. The package contains the documents and additional information required to submit the application to the Verkehrsamt, like your original driver's license, a certified translation of your original driver's license, Meldezettel (Austrian residency document) plus a copy of the Meldezettel, EU-passport photo (not older than 6 months), a valid photo ID, the confirmation from the school that you are completing the exchange with us and a valid doctor's report.

In order to apply for the license Exchange at the Verkehrsamt, you first need to get an appointment. To get an appointment, please [sign up here](#).

After you have submitted the application, it takes about 3-4 months for it to be processed. If everything is fine, you will get an approval from the Verkehrsamt and can start your education with us.

Theoretical course for license exchange Driving school

You already have your driver's license, so the theoretical course is focusing on the traffic rules and signs that apply in Austria in order to give you a good preparation for the practical driving test. It is important to keep in mind that being able to drive and passing a driving test are two very different things. For the driving test you not only have to show that you can handle a car or motorcycle - you also have to show that you know the traffic rules and signs that are specific to Austria. The course lasts about two hours and is supplemented by a small textbook and a booklet for the practical test - both are in either Farsi, German or English. Einweisungsstunde SeeStadt + surroundings

Before you start practicing on your own, you and your companion must complete a training lesson (Einweisungsstunde) with a driving instructor at the driving school. In this lesson you and your supervisor will receive a valuable practical and theoretical introduction to how to practice driving and what you should specifically focus on to be optimally prepared for the practical driving test. The Einweisungsstunde is easily and conveniently [booked online](#) or in the driving school.

Introduction to the learning permit Driving school

Part of the application for the learner's permit is the introduction to the learner's permit theoretical course, which you and your designated supervisor need to attend. The introduction lasts about an hour, and here the tasks, training and challenges of practicing driving are discussed.

Test simulation (optional) SeeStadt + surroundings

A few months after receiving the confirmation for the practice drives, you and the person you are practising with should be ready for the test simulation with a driving instructor and your car in the driving school. In this driving lesson, any errors/inaccuracies will be discussed and you will receive tips on how to best proceed in order to get the most out of the practice sessions. The test simulation can be booked easily [online](#) or in the driving school.

Practical driving test (optional) SeeStadt + surroundings

Finally, the driving tests...:) You have now completed the education, including the theory course, the practice on the training track, the evaluation lesson for car and motorcycle and any additional driving lessons, and should be well prepared. Only the practical driving test remains - but don't be nervous, OK? The tests are not about being the best driver in the world, but about being a competent, safe and responsible road user.
