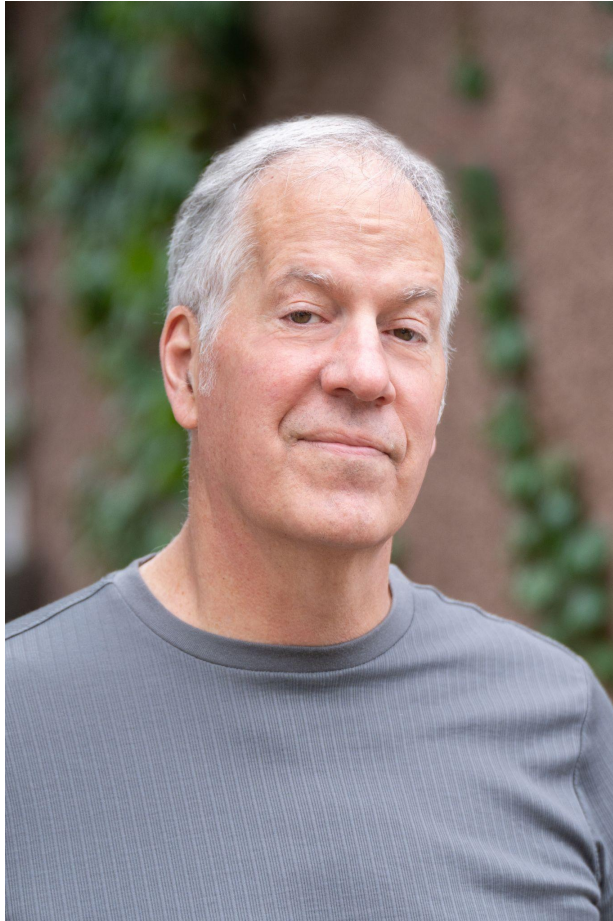




Dr. Dave Juehring
