### 5. Expected Conference Outputs:

- 01 Vietnamese conference proceedings of the International Conference published by a reputable publishing house recognized by the State Council for Professorship.

- 01 English conference proceedings of the International Conference published by a reputable publishing house recognized by the State Council for Professorship

### 6. Submission Guidelines

**Abstract Submission Deadline:** Authors are required to submit the title and an abstract (in both Vietnamese and English) by **June 15, 2026**.

a) The abstract should not exceed 250 words and must include keywords.

Authors will be notified of the review results within 10 working days after the submission deadline.

b) Full Paper Submission Deadline: By 5:00 PM (GMT+7), **August 15, 2026**.

c) Full Paper Requirements: Manuscripts must adhere to the scientific paper format guidelines (see attached appendix).

d) Languages: Submissions can be in either English or Vietnamese (English is strongly encouraged).

The Editorial Board may recommend translation or language adjustment based on the publication's orientation.

### 7. Peer Review and Proceedings Publication

All submissions will undergo independent peer review of the abstract and full text. Accepted papers will be published in the full conference proceedings.

All scientific papers will be checked for textual originality using AI-supported tools. Manuscripts must maintain a similarity index of 20% or less to ensure originality.

### 8. Participation Fees:

- For authors with papers written in Vietnamese: 1,500,000 VND per paper (60 USD).

- For authors with papers written in English: 2,000,000 VND per paper (80 USD).

- Master's students and doctoral candidates of the Academy: 30% discount.
- Conference proceedings: 200,000 VND (approximately 8 USD)

The conference organizing committee will waive all fees for: Lead authors who are selected as session chairs or keynote speakers, Members of the organizing committee and editorial board, Full-time and adjunct lecturers (at undergraduate and postgraduate levels of the psychology program) at the Vietnam Women's Academy who have been affiliated within the past 3 years.

We sincerely welcome the attention and collaboration of scholars, experts, academics, practitioners, and managers. We encourage you to submit your papers to the Conference.

## APPENDIX

### Full Paper Submission Guidelines for the Conference Proceedings “Mental Health of Women and Children in the Context of the Digital World and Psychological Crisis Risks”

Pursuant to Plan No.93 /KH-HVPNVN dated March 17, 2026 issued by the Vietnam Women’s Academy regarding the organization of the International Conference “*Mental Health of Women and Children in the Context of the Digital World and Psychological Crisis Risks*”, the Academy sets forth the following guidelines for full paper submissions to the Conference Proceedings:

1. **Format:** Manuscripts must be submitted in Microsoft Word format.
2. **Word Count:** Full papers should be no longer than 6,000 words, including all content such as body text, examples, abstract, references, tables, figures, and appendices. Submissions exceeding the word limit may be considered in exceptional cases where authors provide a justified rationale in a cover letter. Manuscripts exceeding 7,500 words will not be considered and will be returned to the authors.
3. **Title:** The title should be concise, informative, and reflect the paper's core content.
4. **Funding Acknowledgement:** Authors must declare all external research funding in the Acknowledgements section, including the role of the funding agency in the study design, execution, and manuscript submission.
5. **Structured Abstract:** All submissions must include a structured abstract with up to 250 words, clearly addressing the following required components:
  - Purpose
  - Design/methodology/approach
  - Key findings
  - Originality/valueOptional components (if applicable):
  - Research limitations/implications
  - Practical implications
  - Social implications

Include **up to 06 relevant keywords**. Keywords may be edited for indexing and discoverability purposes.

**6. Article Classification:** Upon submission, authors must classify their manuscript as one of the following two main types:

- Research Article
- Review Article

After that, authors must choose the most relevant type:

- Research paper: Reports on completed research, including empirical studies, modeling, experimental design, surveys, or field applications.
- Opinion: Presents the author’s personal stance or opinion on a relevant topic.

- Technical paper: Describes or evaluates specific products or processes.
- Theoretical paper: Develops new hypotheses, theoretical models, or philosophical discourse; academic comparison.
- Case study: Provides detailed analysis of a specific intervention or real-life experience; may include subjective insights.
- Literature review: Intended when the primary aim is to examine existing sources.
- General review: Offers synthesized overviews, historical summaries, or "how-to" guidance.

## **7. Suggested Paper Structure**

(1) Introduction: Clearly state the rationale for the study and its relevance. This section should articulate the main objectives of the paper.

(2) Theoretical Framework: Present the theoretical foundation that guides the research design and data analysis.

(3) Research Methodology: Describe in detail the research design, approach, and methods employed.

(4) Findings and Discussion: Present the key findings of the study and provide a critical discussion of the findings.

(5) Conclusion: Summarize the main conclusions, emphasizing the scientific contributions and the economic or social implications of the research, as well as the scale and scope of application. Discuss any limitations and provide recommendations for future studies.

(6) References, Appendices, and List of Previous Works (if applicable): All references, appendices, and the list of the author's prior publications (if any) must follow the Academy's citation guidelines, in accordance with the APA 7th edition referencing style.

*Note: Authors may include additional sections as appropriate to the nature and scope of their research.*

(8) Headings should be clear and hierarchical: Level 1: Bold; Level 2: Bold Level 3: Italic

(9) Footnotes/Endnotes should be used sparingly and numbered in square brackets [1], [2], etc., with full details at the end of the paper.

## **8. Figures and Tables**

Tables, charts, diagrams, screenshots, and technical illustrations must be submitted in electronic format. Visuals may be presented in either color or black and white.

Notes:

- Ensure all visuals are of high resolution with clear text and numbers.
- If created using software tools, submit the original editable files (e.g., Word or PDF).

- Number all visuals sequentially (e.g., Figure 1, Figure 2, etc.) and provide descriptive captions for each.

- For photographs, use labels such as Photo 1, Photo 2, etc.

- If using third-party visuals or data, the source or copyright ownership must be clearly stated.

### **9. Formatting Guidelines:**

- Font style: Times New Roman, size 12. Margins must be at least 2.5 cm (1 inch).

- Numbering and Dates: Use only Arabic numerals (e.g., 14). Dates should be written as follows: 14/4/2025.

- Title: Bold the article title and capitalize proper nouns.

- Author names: Provide the full names of all contributors on the title page.

- Affiliations: Indicate the institutional affiliation of each author (institution, university, city, country).

- Corresponding author: Please provide the institutional email address of the corresponding author.

- Abstract: Clearly display the abstract with a heading and reduced font size.

### **10. References**

References, appendices, and a list of the author's previous publications (if applicable) must follow the Academy's citation guidelines in accordance with APA 7th edition.



### **11. Important Notes**

#### ***Author Responsibilities***

The Organizing Committee is committed to providing authors with a professional and courteous experience throughout the peer-review and publication process. However, authors are also expected to uphold the following responsibilities:

- Respond promptly to all editorial inquiries during the publication process.

- Collaborate closely with the editorial team in revising and editing the manuscript

- Take full responsibility for the accuracy and integrity of the submitted work, including addressing any concerns raised during the review or post-publication stages.

- Maintain confidentiality of all communications with editors until a final editorial decision has been made.

- Authorship should be limited to individuals who have made a substantial and meaningful contribution to the research and manuscript. Contributors who do not meet authorship criteria should be acknowledged in the Acknowledgments section.

- Artificial Intelligence (AI) cannot be credited as an author, as it lacks the capacity for conceptual design and cannot be held accountable for the originality, accuracy, or integrity of the work.

#### ***Research and Publishing Ethics***

- Manuscripts must be original and must not have been previously published in their current or substantially similar form. If any part of the work has been published elsewhere,

this must be disclosed to the editor upon submission.

- Submissions must not be under consideration by any other publication at the same time.

- Any potential conflicts of interest must be disclosed at the time of submission so that the editorial team can make informed decisions.

- Submission of the manuscript implies that the authors warrant the work does not infringe any copyright or intellectual property rights.

- All data, programming code, and methodologies must be properly cited and referenced.

- Where applicable, permanent identifiers (e.g., DOIs) should be included in the references for datasets or source code.

- Authors must adhere to relevant international and national regulations concerning privacy and data protection when citing or using personal or sensitive data.

- Before submission, authors must ensure they have obtained written permission to use any third-party material included in the manuscript.

## **From page 2 (Paper Content)**

### **PAPER TITLE**

- The paper title should be 10–20 words long and directly reflect the content of the paper.
- The paper title must be capitalized, bold, and centered.

### **ABBREVIATION**

- Papers must include an abstract in English or Vietnamese. This section should not contain equations, references, or footnotes.

### **CONTENT**

- Article in English or Vietnamese, maximum 6000 words, A4 size (210 mm × 297 mm).

### **Format:**

- Font: Times New Roman
- Font size: 12
- Title: font size 14 (for both English and Vietnamese)
- Margins: 2.5 cm

### **Title structure:**

- 1. Heading 1** (Lowercase, bold)
- 1.1 Heading 2** (Lowercase, bold)
- 1.2. Heading 3** (Lowercase, italic)

### **TABLES**

- Tables must be numbered and have titles.
- Title: font size 12, bold, centered.

### **FIGURES**

- Figures must have clear and accurate source citations.
- Title should be placed below the figure.
