Conflict is a struggle between two opposing forces of characters in a literary work. Conflict can take one of these forms:

(1) *Character versus Character*

(2) *Character versus Society*

(3) *Character versus Nature*

(4) *Two or more emotions or ideas struggling for mastery within a character (internal conflict)*
