Privacy Policy for Forest Tiles

Your privacy and data security are extremely important to us. When you use our services, you entrust us with your information, and we understand that this is a significant responsibility. If you have any questions, you can always email us at rashedjoni013@gmail.com.

This privacy policy explains our data protection policies and describes the types of information we may process when you use one or more of our mobile applications ("App", "Apps", "Our App", "Our Apps"). It also explains how we and some of the companies we work with handle this information.

I. Information We Collect

1. Data About Your Use of the Service

Click counts, landing pages, pages viewed, apps opened, permission statuses, functionality status, number of apps installed, package names, app brands, network status of the app, firebase_device_id, app model, SIM country/region, system language, cookies that advertisers can store or read, etc. This data is only shared with certified third-party analytics platforms: Firebase and our self-built data statistics system (ECS). This information is used solely to improve the product experience and is not shared with any third parties. We do not use this information for any purposes other than improving the product experience and advertising effectiveness.

2. Device Information

We collect your device and network connection information to provide you with a better experience while using our app. This information depends on the environment in which you interact with us, your choices (including privacy settings), and the products and features you use, and may include:

SDK/API version, platform, timestamp, app identifier, app version, unique device identifier, device manufacturer, OS version, language locale, timezone, and network status (e.g., Wi-Fi), app's release status on Google Play, ad loading strategy, ad platform, and ad serving IDs.

We store information collected via the Android ID associated with your device, which helps us track your ad behavior while using the app. We treat this information as personal data.

3. Monetization and Analytical Data from Other Sources

Third-party SDKs integrated into our apps may access your information, including:

Google Ad ID

Demographic data (e.g., determining your IP address)

Fraud prevention data (e.g., click fraud in ads)

Device-related data (e.g., device type, technical info, country/region)

Data for ads, marketing, and analytics

Cookies that advertisers can store or read

The information collected by these third-party SDKs is managed by their respective providers, and we do not control these third parties. These third parties include monetization partners like Google Admob, Facebook Audience Network, IronSource, AppLovin, Vungle, Unity, Fyber, Amazon, Pangle, and analytics partners like Firebase, Facebook Analytics, and our own data system. 4. Android Advertising ID

We use your Android advertising ID to provide you with personalized advertising experiences. It is used solely for advertising and analytics purposes. Please note that the ad identifier does not contain any sensitive personal information about you or your device. It is not linked to personally identifiable information or any permanent device identifiers (e.g., SSAID, MAC address, IMEI).

5. Other Information

We may collect information that you voluntarily provide directly to us, such as your email address, feedback, and answers to surveys.

II. How We Use This Information

To improve your experience while using our services, we may ask you to provide certain personal information. The information we ask for will remain on your device, and we do not collect it in any other way

As mentioned above, we collect your information for analytical purposes, and this data is only used for app optimization.

As described above, your personal information may be shared with our third-party partners. We may disclose your personal information to our business partners, including advertisers, publishers, and data tracking companies. These partners may use your personal information to show you ads, measure your interactions with ads/websites, and better understand website and app traffic usage or user behavior to improve their services. These partners' use of the information we disclose to them will be governed by their respective privacy policies.

III. Legal Basis for Processing Your Personal Data

As described above, we process personal data for the purposes outlined in this privacy policy. The legal bases for processing your personal data include:

Processing necessary for the performance of a contract with you (e.g., providing you with the services you request and verifying your identity)

Processing necessary to comply with legal obligations (e.g., complying with applicable accounting regulations and mandatory disclosures to law enforcement)

Processing based on our legitimate interests (e.g., managing our relationship with you, ensuring the security of our services, and communicating with you about our products and services)

Processing based on the consent of our customers (e.g., placing certain cookies and sharing your information with third parties for advertising purposes)

In certain cases, you may need to provide us with personal data to allow us to provide all the services and features of our app.

IV. Your Rights

When you use our services, we provide you with the rights outlined below. If you wish to exercise the rights granted by applicable law, please contact us at rashedjoni013@gmail.com. When we receive your personal rights request, please ensure that you are ready to verify your identity. Please note that your personal rights are limited. We may limit your personal rights in cases where access is denied by law or authorization; when granting access would negatively impact others' privacy; to protect our rights and property; or when the request is frivolous or excessive.

1.Right to Withdraw Consent

If we rely on your consent to process your personal information, you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time. Withdrawing consent will not affect the legality of the processing we conducted prior to your withdrawal or the legality of processing by any third party based on consent prior to your withdrawal.

2. Right to Access and Rectification

If you request a copy of the personal information we hold about you, we will promptly provide you with a copy free of charge, unless the law allows us to charge a fee. If such access negatively impacts the rights and freedoms of other individuals, we may limit your access. You can also request corrections or updates to any personal information we hold about you unless you can make corrections directly through the service.

3. Right to Be Forgotten

You can request that we delete any personal information we hold about you if:

It is no longer necessary for the purposes for which it was collected or processed

You previously consented to its processing but later withdrew that consent

You object to the processing, and we do not have overriding legitimate grounds for continuing the processing

4. Right to Restrict Processing

You have the right to restrict the processing of your personal information in the following cases:

You challenge the accuracy of your personal information. We will restrict processing while we verify its accuracy, which may result in partial or complete service interruptions

Processing is unlawful, and you oppose deletion of your personal information and request restriction of its use

We no longer need your personal information for processing purposes, but you need it for the establishment, exercise, or defense of legal claims

You object to processing, and we are verifying whether our legitimate grounds override your rights

We will only process your restricted personal data with your consent, to establish, exercise, or defend legal claims, to protect the rights of other individuals or entities, or for reasons of substantial public interest. If restrictions are lifted, we will notify you.

5. Right to Object to Processing

If we process your personal information based on consent, contract, or legitimate interests, you can object to our processing at any time under applicable law. We may continue processing your personal information if necessary for the defense of legal claims or any other exceptions permitted by law.

6. Right to Data Portability

If we process your personal information based on a contract with you or your consent, or if the processing is automated, you have the right to request your personal data in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format. Where technically feasible, we will transfer your personal information directly to another controller unless doing so would adversely affect the rights and freedoms of others.

7. Notification of Third Parties

If we share your personal information with third parties, we will notify them of any corrections, deletions, or restrictions on your personal information unless this is impossible or requires disproportionate effort. Upon request, we will identify such third parties.

8. Automated Individual Decision-Making, Including Profiling

You have the right not to be subject to decisions based solely on automated processing of your personal information (including profiling), which produce legal effects concerning you or similarly significantly affect you unless exceptions apply under applicable law.

9. Right to File a Complaint

You also have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority in your habitual residence, place of work, or where the alleged infringement occurred.

VI. California Residents

We have a separate privacy statement for California consumers in compliance with the California Consumer Privacy Act (CCPA) and other California privacy laws. This statement supplements the information described above and applies only to users residing in California.

If you are not a California resident, this policy does not apply to you. Please refer to our main privacy statement.

1. Your Right to Request Information

Under the CCPA, you (or your authorized agent) have the right to request that we disclose how we have collected, used, and shared your personal information in the past 12 months. This information includes:

The categories of personal information we have collected

The categories of sources from which we collected personal information

The business purposes for collecting personal information

The categories of third parties with whom we share personal information

2. Your Right to Deletion

Under the CCPA, you (or your authorized agent) have the right to request that we delete certain personal information we have collected and retained, with exceptions. These exceptions include:

We need your information to detect security incidents and prevent malicious or illegal activity

We need your information to identify and fix app bugs that affect its expected functionality

We need your information to exercise free speech and to ensure others can do the same

We need your information for internal purposes aligned with your expectations based on our relationship

3. How to Exercise Your Rights

To exercise the above rights, submit a verifiable consumer request to rashedjoni013@gmail.com. Only you or your authorized agent can submit a verifiable request regarding your personal information. You may submit two verifiable requests within 12 months.

4. How We Respond to Your Request

We strive to respond to verifiable consumer requests within 45 days. If we need more time (up to 90 days), we will notify you by email, phone, or other electronic means, explaining the delay. We do not charge fees for processing or responding to verifiable

consumer requests unless the request is excessive, repetitive, or manifestly unfounded. If we determine that fees are required, we will inform you beforehand.

5. No Discrimination

We will not discriminate against you for exercising your CCPA rights. Discrimination includes:

Denying you our services

Charging you different prices or rates

Providing you with different levels or qualities of services

6. Children's Data Collection

Our services are not intended for anyone under the age of 13. We do not knowingly collect personal information from children under 13. If we become aware that a child under 13 has provided us with personal information, we will immediately delete that information from our servers. If you are a parent or guardian and know that your child has provided us with personal information, please contact us so we can take necessary measures.

VII. Residents of the EU and UK

If you reside in the UK or another EU member state, you have certain rights under EU data protection law. You may request that we:

Confirm whether we are processing your personal data and inquire about the types of personal data we hold about you

Change or rectify your data

Delete your data

Stop using your data if we no longer have a legal right to process it

Provide you with a copy of the personal data you provided to us in a machine-readable format

If you believe we have not complied with data protection laws, you also have the right to file a complaint with your local data protection authority.

VIII. Children's Privacy

Our Service does not address anyone under the age of 13. We do not knowingly collect personally identifiable information from anyone under the age of 13. If You are a parent or guardian and You are aware that Your child has provided Us with Personal Data, please contact Us. If We need to rely on consent as a legal basis for processing Your information and Your country requires consent from a parent, We may require Your parent's consent before We collect and use that information.

Any information we collect is subject to the policy in effect at the time of collection. However, we may revise this policy from time to time. If we make such changes, we will notify you through specific updates or notifications. Continuing to use our apps or services after changes to this policy indicates your acceptance of those changes.
