1.	Hours burning allowed: From 6:00 p.m. to midnight.
2.	Burning is <b>NOT</b> allowed on Sundays and Legal Holidays.
3.	Burn when the wind is less than 8 mph.
4.	Have firefighting tools and water on the site before fire is started.
5.	A non-combustible fire break of 5 feet shall surround the burn barrel.
6.	Fire must be attended at all times and must be totally extinguished before you leave it.
7.	For purposes of forest fire prevention, a burn barrel shall have air holes no larger than ½ inch in diameter and a cover with holes no larger than ¼ inch in diameter. In addition, the inside of the barrel should be free of any residue or contamination of any kind.
8.	The burning of asphalt, rubber, plastic oily substances, wet paper and wet garbage is prohibited.
9.	Additional Restrictions: WATCH FOR BURNING BANS
