### *Current Business / Action Items (Updates)*

Shade Structure	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>★ Jane and Kathy met with Rescue to discuss the shade structure.</li> <li>★ We talked about planting trees as an alternative to a shade structure, and he was against the idea because he doesn't like the maintenance, and it has the same problem as building a shade structure. You would have to break through the barrier with asbestos.</li> <li>★ They are looking at a shade system that will attach to the existing playground.</li> <li>★ We are going to get quotes for the playground next to extended day and the kindergarten playground to see if it's feasible or not.</li> <li>★ Rescue is working with the playground manufacturers to see if there's an attachment that can be added to existing structures to avoid breaking the barrier.</li> <li>★ Getting sails attached to the building approved would require multiple surveys to ensure it's safe since it would be above the kids. It would need to be reviewed and approved by a state agency.</li> </ul>

Santa Run	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>★ Good turnout.</li> <li>★ Jen and Kate took charge and did a lot of work on it.</li> </ul>
Holiday Shop	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>★ It was a fabulous event.</li> <li>★ We ran out of a lot of stuff, so we need to figure out how to incentivize teachers to pick their times later.</li> <li>★ Using Amazon, Dollar Tree, etc. was much better than using Penguin Patch.</li> <li>★ We made \$3.9k in profit.</li> <li>★ We should look into getting it on the calendar sooner in the future.</li> </ul>
Father Daughter Dance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>★ Tyson met with Jane, Holly, and Gina Maki. Gina is heading it up.</li> <li>★ Tentatively looking at 2/24, from 6:30-8:30 (the Friday before Read-A-Thon).</li> <li>★ It's a minimum day, which will help with setup.</li> <li>★ Princess Ball theme.</li> <li>★ We're working on renting tables, and getting a DJ.</li> <li>★ Ashley will help with creative graphics to get the info out.</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>★ We will use Greater Giving for ticket sales and take payments online.</li> </ul>
Fifth Grade Promotion	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>★ Kathy will talk to the teachers to see what they want to do for this event.</li> <li>★ Biggest concern is keeping things with the class versus with families.</li> <li>★ We have \$1.5k set aside for shirts.</li> </ul>

Upcoming Events	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>★ Read-A-Thon <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Looking at using a different software/system this year</li> <li>○ \$500 budget</li> <li>○ Last year we spent approx \$400</li> <li>○ Looking into homework passes or extra recess as incentives</li> <li>○ Tentative dates: 2/24-3/10</li> <li>○ This year our goal is \$25k.</li> </ul> </li> <li>★ Father-Daughter Dance - 2/24</li> </ul>
Spring Enrichment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>★ Bethany, Kathy, and Tyson are working out the issues from Fall Enrichment.</li> <li>★ Registration will start 2/1.</li> <li>★ We have the same providers as last time, but hoping to get three more.</li> </ul>
Blacktop Art	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>★ Lora Watts</li> <li>★ Blacktop paint helps with heat island effect. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Up to a 40 degree reduction in heat on the blacktop.</li> </ul> </li> <li>★ Helps preserve asphalt beneath it.</li> <li>★ Some paint can be applied by novices. They can also be professionally installed.</li> <li>★ We will need board approval for the designs.</li> <li>★ We think the lines have been painted on the</li> </ul>

	<p>blacktop before, but it's been several years.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>★ If you do it right, you would redo the blacktop. Paint goes down best on fresh asphalt.</li> <li>★ There are no current plans to redo the blacktop, but we can see when the next rotation occurs. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ There is now specialty asphalt which would do more than the paint would.</li> </ul> </li> <li>★ Looking at \$2-4 per square foot</li> <li>★ If you do a full basketball court, you're looking at \$8k. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ That includes cost of installation and resurfacing.</li> </ul> </li> <li>★ Artistic paint lasts 3-5 years. Professional paint, they say they get up to 12 years.</li> <li>★ Both artistic and professional paint offer heat reduction.</li> <li>★ Basketball court would be more like \$4-5k with artistic paint.</li> <li>★ Lana would be able to provide a cost estimate for concrete paint to paint the kindergarten playground.</li> <li>★ We could consider gradually adding artistic touches to the school.</li> <li>★ We will wait for an idea on when the blacktop is scheduled to be repaved before making any decisions.</li> </ul>
Pancake Breakfast	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>★ We're going to start working on the pancake breakfast.</li> </ul>
PTO Board Next Year	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>★ Start thinking of who wants to continue on the board so we can start working on recruitment.</li> </ul>
