Annual Distraction-Free Schools Enforcement Report

2025-26 School Year



In accordance with the New York State's Distraction-Free Schools Law, LaFargeville Central School District provides the following annual report regarding enforcement of its distraction-free schools policy.

Enforcement Summary

During the 2025-26 school year, the District documented 19 student violations of the distraction-free schools policy. All violations were addressed in accordance with Board of Education policy and the District's established procedures.

Non-Identifiable Demographic Data and Analysis of Enforcement

The District reviewed disciplinary actions related to distraction-free schools enforcement by student demographic groups. The District's review did not identify statistically significant demographic disparities in the enforcement of its distraction-free schools policy.

Mitigation Plan

Because no statistically significant enforcement disparities were identified, no mitigation action plan is required at this time. The District will continue to monitor implementation of the policy to ensure fair, consistent, and equitable enforcement.
