- Feels that AF and OCL have a handle on partnerships and that adding an additional 3rd party to that equation will complicate things and should be avoided.

- He suggested we focus on growth opportunities in Asia. "Take a look at the roles currently available at Berachain for some examples: <https://careers.berachain.com/>. Dan Reecer (https://twitter.com/danreecer_) provides an excellent benchmark for the ideal growth candidate, given his successful track record in promoting Polkadot before moving to Wormhole. Focusing on growth, in my opinion, could be significantly more impactful than concentrating on business development or partnerships."

Correspondence w/ Chewieeee (Shin) | Arbitrum Foundation:

to measure growth in the Asia market, we can look at a few perspective such as the growth of TVL, increased developer activity, and an enhanced developer experience. onboarding users across different verticals like DeFi, gaming, RWA, and social would also be valuable. additionally, having builders in each region who can focus on dedicated use cases tailored to their respective communities, (eg: increasing access to capital in SEA, would be advantageous.)

while Arbitrum is already well-known within the crypto communities in APAC, our presence in the region can be further strengthened. to achieve this, we should consider organizing more meetups co-hosted with local communities across various APAC countries, as well well has more content produced in the local languages. Asia, especially SEA, has a growing number of developers interested in web3 and transitioning from web2 to web3. hosting tech bootcamps and workshops specifically about Stylus would be an excellent way to attract and onboard developers. currently, we have limited local tech resources in the APAC region. it would greatly benefit us if we could have someone technically proficient in Arbitrum technology to speak and present at these bootcamps/ workshops
