-Salem witch trials,(Old Vista Witch Trials) support each other burn the suspected witches of New Vista

What are some historical events, movements, discoveries or people that might relate to this core value? (Think about the respect vaccine as a parallel to the flu vaccine)

-Salem Witch Trials (Old Vista Witch Trials)

Talk about how many stories you might have. What would your outline look like? You need to keep it under five minutes.

-Start off with all students being very socially awkward, reclusive, etc. Feature a scene with two people "almost" interacting but not speaking because they don't know how to socialize.

-film the witches in the boiler room/back gym room with candles before anyone knows they exist (Ivette?) and have someone walk in on the ritual (Kirk?)

-Kirk awkwardly tells people that Ivette is a witch

-people congregate and plan together

-witch burning

-from that point on there were regular community gatherings

-Spirit of Ivette (the burned witch) pops up on projector screen one community gathering and tells the community that her plan/ spell has succeeded So why is ivette here today if she was burned?

Consider the respect episode. Write an introduction that Joel would deliver and plan out any transitions between pieces. Try usid Acid in your writing

Introduction--

Welcome back to the History Channel, today we will be delving into the dark days of the Old Vista Witch Trials, a turning point in New Vista's history. New Vista has not always had such a supportive community. It's inhabitants used to be dark, socially awkward, reclusive. (footage of people not talking to each other, example of human interaction) Unknown to the general population of Old Vista, there were people- witches, rather- that planned to change Old Vista with spells and potions.

One in particular, Ivetticus Mortem, planned to cast a spell on the people of Old Vista, one that would bind them together as a community..... FOREVER. (Show footage of Ivette w/ candles and a cauldron/ wand in the boiler room or gym, speaking some sort of gibberish.) One day, while mixing a support potion, Madame Mortem was interrupted by a lost citizen, wandering aimlessly to pass the time. (cut to Kirk walking in on Ivette's spell.) The man was terrified, and knew he needed to tell someone. (Cut to awkward conversation with Kirk and some other really awkward people, Kirk telling them what he'd just seen.) Before they knew it, the Old Vistians were communicating and planning on how to rid the school of the witch. (cut to meeting, map plans, etc.) They had come to a conclusion. (Cut to Witch burning.)

(Fast forward to present day) To this day, New Vistians have been a supporting community, gathering every week to converse different ways to be supportive as a community. (Cut to projection at community gathering of the spirit of Ivetticus Mortem saying that her spell has worked.) (Interview Ivette about how Ivetticus Mortem was her ancestor, what she knows about her, etc.)
