Community Service Learning Activity



The MYP Design Course is being offered to all students at Imperial Middle School. This framework of learning encourages students to become creative, critical and reflective thinkers.

Students are required to attend 50 hours of a Design course. This will be done through their Science class and one other class. Final projects are expected to be completed and showcased to the community.

As part of the candidacy phase of the International Baccalaureate program, all students are expected to participate in the Community Service Learning activity.

This opportunity will be provided through their TLC advisement period that meets 3 times a week.

Grades 6 + 7th are expected to complete at least two hours of volunteering service which can be done in the neighborhood, at religious institutions or the community. Students will complete an e-journal to reflect on their experience.

Grade 8 students will investigate a need in the community and create a solution to the issue. They will showcase their completed project to parents and community members upon completion of the project cycle. Students will complete an e-journal to reflect on their experience.
