Invitation

This is the teaching deck for One Anothering (From Him), including the message video. Use it for gathering, breakouts, and review. The slides walk from the Body metaphor through the three commands — loving, accepting, and building — and land on Christ as source.

Key Points

- Same core message as the sermon PDF, prepared for visual teaching and group use.
- Christ is Head; believing members are baptized into the Body.
- 59 “one another” commands summarize the local body’s life together.
- Loving one another is sourced in God, not manufactured by effort (1 John 4:7).
- Accepting one another flows from being accepted in Christ (Rom 15:7).
- Building up one another is the aim of every gathering (1 Cor 14:26).
- Breakout prompts are included: revelations received, and a story of loving, accepting, or building up another.
- Designed for Grace Christian Church’s 1st-century house-church model — in person and on Zoom.

- How can a slide deck serve the Body without turning the gathering back into a spectator event?
- What would it look like for every person in the room to contribute after this message?
