BEST FEATURE:

The team commends the strong collaborative relationship of the Holy Trinity University with the local LGUs, NGOs, and other GOs that provide the strengthening of outreach services of the university in general and the College of Nursing in particular.

The immediate identification of and entry into a new community to meet the academic needs of the students in their community health nursing course evidenced by:</p> <p>a. a community development plan based on community assessment and diagnosis and aligned with the over-all university community development plan.</p>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Implemented ● HTU-CNHS has identified Bgy. Mangingisda as new community partner for students' RLE community exposure for school year 2023-2024 onwards. Though this area had been a long-time partner of the institution, there has been no community exposure since 2018 due to the need to have nearby community partners in compliance to PAASCU's last recommendation considering student safety and distance of the barangay. But as the institution's latest evaluation of nearby communities (Bgy. San Pedro) suggest, HTU has renewed its partnership with Bgy. Mangingisda considering the needs of the community and the receptiveness of the people. HTU has also provided a safer mode of student transport by purchasing two units of bus. <u>MOA with Bgy.</u>
