Item	Amount	Justification
Assorted Candy	14	Used for block party and tabling, price was obtained from Target for 14.39 for 125 count of Snickers, Twix, Milky Way, 3 Musketeers Assorted Milk Chocolate Candy Bars - 125 Ct. This same bag was 18 dollars at Walmart, and 16 dollars at walgreens, so we chose Target.
Trifold Poster Board	11	Poster board will be used for block party, price was obtained from the "Pen + Gear Ultra Strong White Tri-Fold Foam Board, 36" x 48", 1/Pack" at Walmart for 10.39. This was the cheapest place for this size of poster board.
Stickers	18	Used for block party and tabling, price was obtained from Amazon for 200 stickers for 17.99. These were the cheapest custom stickers we could find.
Plastic Tablecloth	1	Will be used at block party, price was obtained from Walmart for a plastic table cloth for 97 cents. This was cheaper than the other options we found.
Cookies	100	Used for a callout meeting, price was obtained from Insomnia cookies for the 50 pack of regular cookies for 100 dollars. This was cheaper than other cookie companies such as Crumbl.
Donuts	30	Will be used for our second event. Price was obtained from Krispy Kreme for 2 dozen of their regular donuts for 14.99 a dozen. This was cheaper than other donut places.
Colored Paper	5	Used for flyers and trifold decoration. Price was obtained from Amazon for 5 dollars for an assorted colored paper pack with 20 sheets of each colors, this was the smallest and cheapest set of colored paper we could find.
