### Visual Arts Beginning (Ms. Alexander/Ms. Mann)

#### **Daily Supplies (bring to every class period):**

- Sketchbook (we will be making this in class, to be kept in the art room)
- Regular #2 pencils
- Eraser (white or kneaded)

## Advanced Studio Art I Honors (Ms. Alexander)

- Sketchbook, 8x10 or larger, at least 30 pages or deconstruction book
- 1 set of dry color media (chalk pastels, oil pastels, or colored pencils)
- 1 set of drawing pencils (HB-6B)
- Eraser
- Hand held pencil sharpener
- Black permanent markers or pens with tip variety (i.e., Sharpie, Micron, Tombow)
- Collage materials and glue sticks for sketchbook work.
- 1 set of acrylic paints or watercolors
- 1 set of brushes
- Students may want to purchase their favorite media to use at home.

## Advanced Studio Art II Honors (Ms. Mann)

Students may want to purchase a set of their favorite media to use at home (examples; a set of prismacolors, acrylic paint, or pastels)

### **Supplies (Needed EVERY class period)**

- Sketchbook: Approximately 8"x10" or 8.5"x11" (at least 50 blank pages)
- #2 Pencils
- Eraser (any kind)
- Black permanent markers or pens such as Microns or Sharpies.

## IB Visual Arts (Ms. Mann)

Students will have access to a variety of media at school. However, students will need to purchase materials to use at home (examples; a set of prismacolors, acrylic paint, printmaking materials, or pastels).

### **Supplies (Needed EVERY class period)**

- Sketchbook, 8x10 or larger, at least 30 pages
- Computer (when working on Comparative Study)
- Regular #2 pencils
- Eraser, any kind
- Hand held pencil sharpener
- Journaling/Collage materials: Pens, highlighters, washi tape, sticky notes, etc.

## AP Drawing (Mr. Puckett)

Students will need to purchase a set of their favorite media to use at home (examples; a set of prismacolors, acrylic paint, printmaking materials, or pastels).

- Sketchbook, 8x10 or larger, at least 30 pages
- Regular #2 pencils
- Shading pencil (ebony, or 6b or higher)
- Eraser, any kind
- Hand held pencil sharpener

## AP 2D Design & AP Drawing (Ms. Mann)

Students will need to purchase materials to use at home (examples; a set of prismacolors, acrylic paint, oil paint, or pastels) and are expected to purchase their own canvases/art surfaces.

### **Supplies (Needed EVERY class period)**

- Sketchbook: Approximately 8"x10" or 8.5"x11" (at least 50 blank pages)
- #2 Pencils
- Eraser (any kind)
- Black permanent markers or pens such as Microns or Sharpies.

**Items you may need to purchase and bring to class or keep at home. We could also use donations of these materials to the art closet:**

- Ebony Pencils
- White Eraser
- Set of oil or chalk pastels (12 count)
- Colored Pencils: Prismacolor (preferred)
- Alcohol based markers
- Acrylic paint brush set
- Acrylic Paint or Watercolor set
- Glue Sticks

### **Additionally**

- Students will need to have the ability to take photos (phone or digital camera) and print (home color printer, or school black and white).
- 2D AP incorporates multimedia, painting, collage, photography, digital art, and fibers. Many of these require students to supply their own materials, canvases, and digital equipment for successful completion of the coursework. These materials can be stored at school during the week and taken home when needed.

## AP 3D Design (Mr. Puckett)

Students must purchase needed materials to use at home (examples; wire, fabric, a set of acrylic paint, plaster, clay, etc.)

- Sketchbook, 8x10 or larger, at least 30 pages
- Regular #2 pencils
- Shading pencil (ebony, or 6b or higher)
- Eraser, any kind
- Hand held pencil sharpener
- Various pens, colored pencils, washi tape, collage materials, glue stick, and markers for sketchbook work.
- Ability to take photos (phone or digital camera) and print (home color printer, or school black and white).
- AP 3D incorporates clay, wire, wood carving, found object sculpture, fibers, metalwork, jewelry, and more. Depending on the student's chosen medium, materials and supplies will need to be purchased for successful completion of the course. These materials can be stored at school during the week and taken home when needed.
