## SELECTION PROCEDURE for the MISSION BAY HIGH SCHOOL NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY

Membership in the National Honor Society (NHS) is an honor bestowed on a student. Students who meet the criteria requirements will be invited to apply for membership.

A student who meets the academic requirements of at least a 3.50 GPA becomes automatically eligible for membership at the beginning of the sophomore year and remains eligible in grade twelve, providing the academic requirements continue to be met. If an eligible student wishes to be considered as a candidate for membership, he/she must complete a NHS application form. A candidate must have been in attendance at school for the equivalent of one semester.

Selection of members for the National Honor Society shall be by majority vote of the faculty council. The council may invite all faculty members to make comments on the candidates.

The criteria for membership are: outstanding scholarship, character, leadership and service as defined as follows:

<u>Scholarship</u>: The student must have a cumulative scholarship average of at least 3.5 on a 4.0 scale. The difficulty of a student's coursework may be considered as one of the selection criteria.

<u>Character</u>: This is probably the most difficult criterion to define. A person of character demonstrates the following six qualities: respect, responsibility, trustworthiness, fairness, caring and citizenship. The student of character takes criticism willingly and accepts recommendations graciously; consistently exemplifies desirable qualities of behavior (cheerfulness, friendliness, poise, stability); upholds principles of morality and ethics; cooperates by complying with school regulations concerning property, programs, office, halls, etc.; demonstrates the highest standards of honesty and reliability; observes rules and instructions, both inside and outside the classroom, manifests truthfulness in acknowledging obedience to rules, avoiding cheating in written work, and also avoids profiting by the mistakes of others.

<u>Leadership</u>: There shall be evidence that the student has taken the initiative in class and school activities, has striven to train and aid others to attain the same objective, and has been willing to sacrifice personal interests for the interest of others.

<u>Service</u>: A willingness to volunteer his/her time and abilities to help others, without monetary compensation or public recognition, shall have been shown by the student both in everyday routine work and in special situations.
