



## Classroom Parties and Celebrations

Please note that the list **allows for foods with possible nut cross contamination**, like "May Contain Tree Nuts" or "Produced in a Facility That Also Processes Peanuts". These statements are voluntary and not required by law.

**The list does NOT cover all food allergies.**

**Parents are responsible for reviewing the approved "[Nut-Limited Snack List](#)" for their child's safety.** If your child has any food allergies or intolerances, communication with school is key and **supplying alternative snacks for the teacher to have on hand is strongly recommended.**

Parents are always welcome to make arrangements to send alternative food to school for their own child's consumption at any of these events.
