2024-25 Building Goals



As part of the USD 497 School Improvement process, all district schools conduct a needs assessment and develop annual goals that are aligned with the district's strategic plan, Kansas State Board of Education Outcomes, and the Kansas Definition of a Successful High School Graduate. Below you will find the 2024-25 goals for Deerfield Elementary.

BUILDING GOAL #1

ELA:

By the end of the 2024-2025 school year, student cohort data in grades 1, 3, 4, and 5 will increase by at least 10% as measured by the Spring 2024 and Spring 2025 Fastbridge growth reports.

1st grade: 65%

3rd grade: 62%

4th grade: 44%

5th grade: 42%

By the end of the 2024-2025 school year, 65% of students in grade K and 2 will achieve typical or aggressive growth as measured by the Spring 2025 Fastbridge growth report.

By the end of the 2024-25 school year, 75% of students in grades K-5 will score as low-risk or on-track on the Spring FastBridge aMath or earlyMath assessment.
