***CRITICAL:** Do Not Use Symbols, Special Characters, Footnotes, Math in Paper Title or cited articles in the abstract. This electronic document is a “live” template and already defines the components of your paper [title, text, heads, etc.] in its style sheet.

1. Introduction

Use A4 paper size (210 x 297 mm) and adjust the margins to those shown in Table 1.

1.1 Formatting the title

The title is set in bold 12-point Times New Roman, justified. The first letter of the title should be capitalised with the rest in lower case.

1.2 Formatting the text

The text of your paper should be formatted as follows:

10-point Times, Times Roman or Times New Roman.

- i. The text should be set to single line spacing.
- ii. Paragraphs should be justified.

2. Literature Review

Equations should be centred and should be numbered with the number on the right-hand side as shown in Equation (1).

$$A = B+C \quad (1)$$

3. Methodology

Figures and tables, as originals of good quality and well contrasted, are to be in their final form, ready for reproduction, pasted in the appropriate place in the text.

4. Finding and Analysis

Define abbreviations and acronyms the first time they are used in the text, even after they have been defined in the abstract.

5. Conclusion

Use either SI (MKS) or CGS as primary units. (SI units are encouraged.) English units may be used as secondary units (in parentheses). An exception would be the use of English units as identifiers in trade, such as “3.5-inch disk drive.”

Avoid combining SI and CGS units. This often leads to confusion because equations do not balance dimensionally. If you must use mixed units, clearly state the units for each quantity that you use in an equation.

Acknowledgment

The preferred spelling of the word “acknowledgement” Avoid the stilted expression “one of us (R. B. G.) thanks ...”. Instead, try “R. B. G. thanks...”. Put sponsor acknowledgments in the unnumbered footnote on the first page.
