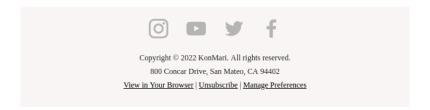

## Cleaning is Not Tidying



One of the most common misconceptions about The KonMari Method™ is that "cleaning" and "tidying" are interchangeable. Not so! Only after you tidy your belongings can you clean the home the way it deserves. Here are six tips to support the process — and how to confirm you're ready to start!

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 KonMari - this email utilizes an 'above the fold' CTA. Meaning the user does not have to scroll before they see the CTA. The email is short and to the point. Shorter emails have a higher click rate than longer emails.

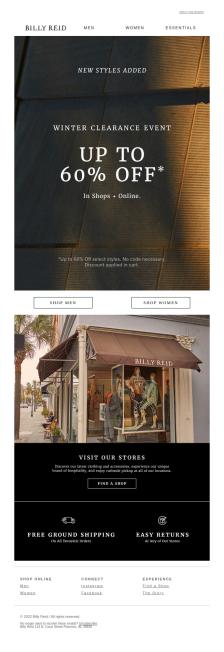
2. Jennifer Adams - This email uses the 'zig zag' method. The CTAs are on alternating columns to advertise products in an eye-catching manner. More info/directions on how to make alternating columns here.



3. The New Savant - This email uses a coupon code in a well designed way. The coupon code is clear and matches the rest of the branding. The email is short, to the point, and focuses only on the coupon rather than the coupon being an afterthought.



4. Nativa Spa - This email is a great example of a giveaway without causing a spam filter trigger. More info on spam words to avoid here.



5. Billy Reid - This template uses two different CTAs. Sometimes using too many CTAs can cause confusion of what the main point of the email is, but this email utilizes more than one CTA well. By only advertising these two main CTAs with clear differences is a good tactic, rather than many different CTAs for similar products.



6. Archipelago - This is a great Black Friday Cyber Sale template. Here we can see that the email is short, punchy, has a coupon/sale related to Cyber Weekend, strong photography/graphics, graphics reflect the coupon/code.

Can design those externally, save them as images, upload into the email template through an image block. One or two large buttons. CTAs at the top/middle of email.

Most subject lines mention the Cyber Weekend deal. Ex: "SUBJECT LINE: Black Friday Sale: Up to 40% Off Fragrance Favorites. PREVIEW TEXT: You Don't Want to Miss This Sale".

Very fine to use all image based emails, just add alt text to all image blocks. Can only have one big graphic that's well designed, and just lead them to click to the website - less is more principle:
