Course Description:					
Level 2 Music develops students' skills as performers, composers, and informed listeners. Entry is recommended for students with at least four years of itinerant or private lessons, with approval from Mrs Allely for other students who do not have four years of experience. Students are encouraged to extend their first instrument and develop a second instrument. There will be the opportunity to perform or support production at Arts and Culture Night in Term 3. The course combines performance, composition, and the study of musical works, allowing students to create and record in any style or genre using tools such as Ableton Live or Hook Theory or students can choose to investigate aspects of New Zealand music.
