

Ballot Status: On the Ballot

Instructions

Fill in the oval darkly and completely for Jill Stein and Rudolph Ware on your ballot. Do NOT write it in!

<u>Sample Ballot</u> (Note: Ballots may differ by location – this sample is intended only as an example of the President/Vice President portion of the ballot.)



Voter ID is generally \underline{not} required. Some first-time voters \underline{may} need to $\underline{show\ ID}$ before casting their ballot.

Dates and Deadlines

Absentee Ballot (No Excuse Required)

NOTE: The law requires the State Board of Elections and each local board of elections to refer to absentee ballots as "mail-in ballots" and absentee voting as "mail-in voting." Please note that this change in terminology does NOT change the process of mail-in voting.

REQUEST FOR BALLOT MUST BE RECEIVED BY:

- If you want to receive ballot by mail or fax, October 29, 2024
- If you want to receive ballot online, 5:00 pm on November 1, 2024 (if request sent by mail) or 11:59 pm on November 1, 2024 (if request sent by fax or online)

DEADLINE TO RETURN COMPLETED BALLOT:

- If by mail, must be <u>postmarked by</u> <u>November 5, 2024</u>, and must be <u>received</u>
 by <u>10:00 am on November 15, 2024</u>
- If using a ballot <u>drop box</u>, by **November 5, 2024**
- If hand delivering your ballot, you must deliver it to your <u>local board of</u> <u>elections</u> by **8:00 pm on November 5, 2024**

Early Voting: October 24, 2024 - October 31, 2024 (7:00 am - 8:00 pm at early voting centers)
