Trident is an upcoming mini-con which will be held across the three days of Columbus Day weekend - that's **October 11-13th** at **CardBoard Gaming** in **Odenton, MD** (that's between Annapolis and Washington DC, for you non-Marylanders). The low admission cost is going straight to Wounded Warrior Project, and we have lots of staffers, customers, and GMs volunteering their time to make this small con a great experience and hopefully a solid draw which will generate a great donation for the charity.

To go along with this theme, and all the pirate decorations, we're hoping to have a nice big pile of BOOTY to give away as door prizes - which will include some stuff from the store, but we'd really love your help. I want to get the word out early (and it is indeed early - our mini-con website isn't even up yet).
