 - The artifact can be a document that you have created, a video, a picture, an assignment, test results, or anything else you can think of. If you do not have a digital version of whatever you would like to add you can type it in a google doc, scan it or take a picture of it!
 - You must write a caption for your artifact. This explains why you picked this artifact and what you want it to demonstrate about you as a student. Use the colored strip from homeroom to guide your work.

Goals-->These need to be SMART goals

- You must write out 2 or more goals for the rest of this school year. They should be academic and personal goals, and they must be written as complete sentences. Refer to the goal sheet suggestions given in homeroom.
- You must write out 2 or more goals for the rest of your time at FMS (the next 2.5 years!). They can be academic or personal goals, but they must be written as complete sentences.

1	BEGINNING	Missing more than 2 assignments or website elements Work is done at a very low level (< 50 words)
2	PROGRESSING	Missing 1-2 assignments or website elements Work does not meet expectations for a 6th grader (50-100 words)
3	PROFICIENT	All assignments and activities completed Website has all required features
4	EXEMPLARY	Sections are all well thought out and developed Site is free of errors and typos Site has been arranged in a way that is attractive and easy to navigate Goals are written in SMART goal form All assignments were completed on time Every page has some kind of multimedia element (picture, video, sound clip, etc.)
