2. **Final payment will be due and the tour becomes non-refundable on May 15, 2023.** Prime Tours will send periodic reminders for incremental payments.

Tuesday, Sep 26	Day 4 - Kinloch Rannoch - Dunalastair Hotel
	After included breakfast at the hotel we load the bags on the bus and head out of Edinburgh for these included visits:
	Blackness Castle AKA Ft William. Walk on the very stones you see in the flogging scene and climb through the old ruins.
	Midhope Castle AKA Lallybroch. No Outlander filming location rivals the experience of walking through the arch that Jamie and Claire called home. You can sense their presence and easily imagine all of Jamie's homecomings.
	Hopetoun House . Most famous as the home of the Duke of Sandringham, this lovely manor house and gardens was actually used as over half a dozen different locations in multiple seasons and it's yours to explore. Our guide will help you find them all.
	Included lunch in Stables Kitchens at Hopetoun House
	Falkland AKA 1940's Inverness. Enjoy a wander as you peer in the window looking for Claire's vase and touch the pillar where the ghost of Jamie came to find Claire in Season 1.
	Journey through Pitlochry on our way to our hotel in Kinloch Rannoch.
	Dinner on own
	Overnight Dunalastair Hotel in Kinloch Rannoch or similar
Wednesday, Sep 27	Day 5 - Inverness - Brand NEW AC Marriott on the River Ness
	Included Breakfast at hotel
	We begin the day hiking up the knoll that served as Craigh na Dun . The stones are not there, but the shade of the dancers and the stones remain. Sing me a song...
	From there we begin our journey north stopping at the Highland Folk Museum in Cairngorms National Park. Here you may even be able to participate in a bit of wool waulking.

	Next we will travel on to Culloden Moor and Visitor's Center where you can have lunch on your own in the Cafe and take an audio self-guided tour of the famous battlefield. Prepare to be moved as you see the clan stones and imagine those brave warriors charging this barren field.
	Then it's on to the 3 ancient stone rings that make up Clava Cairns , the original inspiration for Diana's story.
	Check into the AC Marriott Hotel for 2 nights in Inverness.

	Free Day in Inverness with Options for a Loch Ness Boat Cruise or an add-on Day trip to the Isle of Sky
	Optional Highland Malt Whiskey Experience at McGregor's Pub. Revel in the sounds of local musicians in the intimate setting of the McGregor's snug where you'll sample 5 of the best Malt Whiskeys Scotland has to offer.
	Overnight Inverness
Friday, Sep 29	Day 7 - Dunblane Hydro
	After included breakfast at the hotel we load the bags on the bus and head south via Glencoe
	Glencoe visitor center comfort stop
	Then it's off to Callander for lunch in the little town and a photo op to feed the Highland Coos
	After lunch we visit lovely Doune Castle (AKA Castle Leoch... and Winterfell... and Monty Python... but now we mix our tales).
	Overnight at Marine North Berwick Hotel & Spa is Central Scotland's most exclusive retreat. The Castle, which dates back to the 14th century, was once owned by the family of Robert the Bruce.
	Dinner on your own at the hotel.
Saturday, Sep 30	Day 8 - Doubletree at EDI Airport
	Breakfast at the hotel and then load the bags for our last day in Scotland
	Enjoy lunch and a walking tour in the lovely 18th century village of Culross AKA Cranesmuir and several other filming sites in later seasons.

Cancellations and Refunds

Cancellation fees apply to the entire booking, including tour fare, air add-ons, ground transfers, pre- and post- hotel and tour packages. If any components are canceled, you will be responsible for any cancellation fees imposed by the airlines, other transportation carriers, other tour and ground operators, and other hotel properties. You are not entitled to any refund, payment, compensation, or credit except as otherwise provided in this Section. Any refunds will be made directly to the method of payment you used at the time of booking or your travel agent and you must receive your refund directly from these sources. Guests who cancel in writing as set forth below within the dates shown below for any reason, including medical or family reasons, are subject to the following per-person cancellation fees, as applicable.

You hereby agree that losses sustained by Prime Tours in the event of your cancellation would be very difficult or impossible to quantify and that the fees set forth in the below cancellation schedule represent a fair and reasonable assessment as liquidated damages. Since a cancellation likely means a diminished opportunity to sell the same space on other cruises or trips, the cancellation fees below apply regardless of a name change or stateroom resale.

All requests for cancellation must be received in writing. Cancellations cannot be made online. Cancellations received 180 days or more prior to departure, or as stated in your trip flier, are refundable less an administrative fee of a minimum US \$50 per person, or as stated in your trip flier. If cancellation occurs less than 120 days prior to departure, all payments are forfeited, unless otherwise stated in your trip flier. If full payment has not yet been received, the full penalty will still apply and any unpaid balance is due immediately. To protect your investment, Prime Tours highly recommends that you obtain adequate trip cancellation insurance.

This may result in varying itineraries and substitute facilities or attractions of equivalent or better value. In the event of national or local holidays, certain listed features i.e. museums, attractions, etc., may be affected or unavailable. If the cancellation of a scheduled activity is encountered, we will endeavor to provide a suitable substitute if at all possible.

Disabilities and Special Needs

Outside of the United States of America, other countries do not necessarily comply with the ADA. Rental of mobility assistance devices is the responsibility of the guest.* The right is reserved to decline to accept or retain any person as a member of this trip who, in the opinion of Prime Tours is unfit for travel or whose physical or mental condition may constitute a danger to themselves or to others on the trip.
